Services included in the Episode of Care include but are not limited to primary surgeon and assistant surgeon professional fees, facility fees, implant costs (if applicable), anesthesia fees, inpatient imaging, pharmacy and neuromonitoring, and post-surgical consultations with participating providers related to the Episode of Care
