Two different coloured pens or erasable markers.

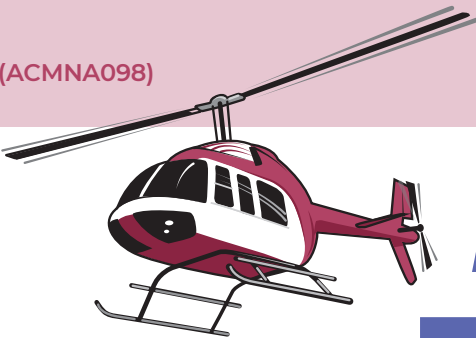

Rules

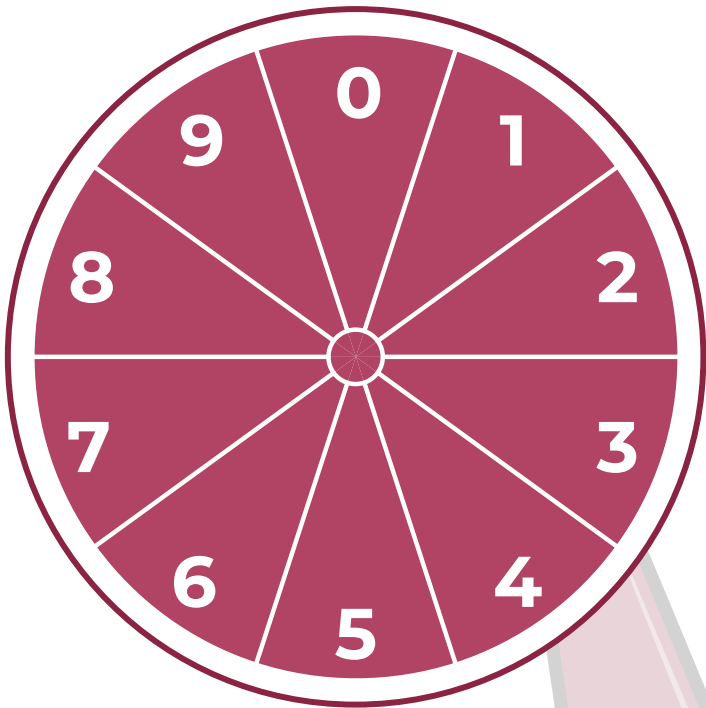
1. Each player spins each of the two spinners and create a 2 digit number. They also spin the 'Multiples Spinner'.
2. They record the multiples of the number from the multiples spinner.
3. If the two digit number they created is one of the multiples, they place a counter on the board.



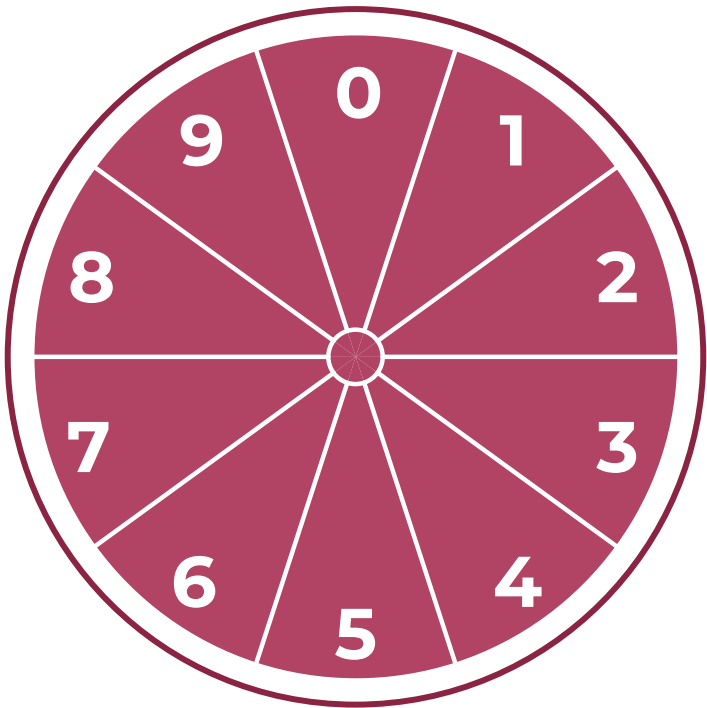

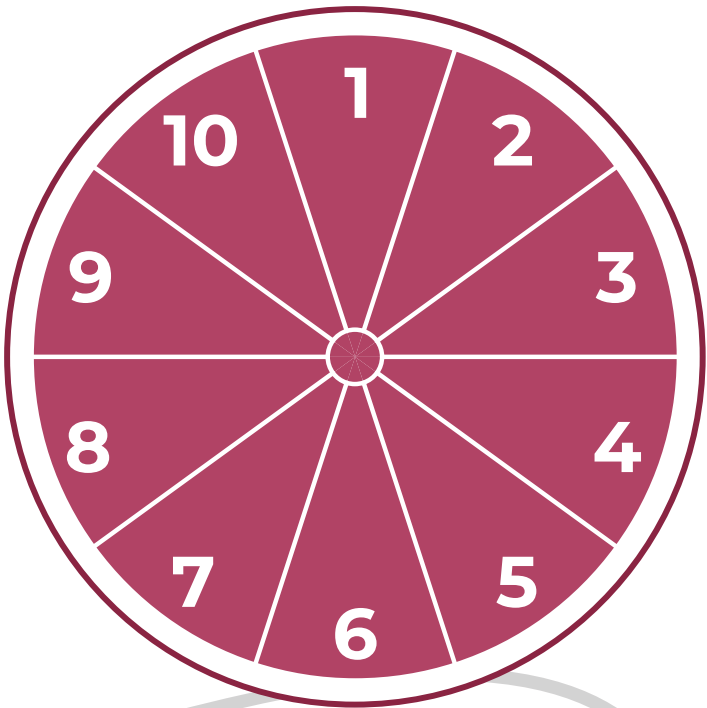
