CPR
At least one household member is certified for: CPR First aid CERT (Citizens Emergency Response Team)
Insurance
O Have a natural disaster policy to cover floods, earthquake, and other natural disasters.
Estate Documents
For parents/adults complete a: Cast will and testament Cast General durable power of attorney. Cast will. Cast will and testament Cast General durable power of attorney. Cast General durable power of attor
Safeguard Documents
Make photocopies or digital backups on a thumb drive of all important documents including: O Have a safe deposit box or fire/water resistant safe to store important documents and cash.
Radio License
O At least one household member has an amateur radio operator license.
N95 Masks
O Have a stock of N95 masks that fit every member of your household.
Food & Water Storage
 Store 1 year of food and toiletries for all household members. Store 1 month of water for your household to include at least 1 gallon of water per person per day.
Financial Reserve
A minimum of \$300 of cash set aside (not money in the bank – physical cash), including small denominations and coins. 3 months of budgeted expenditures in a savings account.
