

Documents To Include in Your Emergency Kits

- Marriage License/Divorce Paperwork.
- Any legal documents with specific instructions (restraining orders, child support, legal directives, power of attorney, etc.)
- Insurance information - Home, vehicle, and any others you may have – also include a phone number for your insurance agent.
- A piece of mail with your current address on it - preferably a utility bill.
- Lease, mortgage and/or rental agreement for your home or property.
- Prescriptions, doctor's notes and/or any supporting medical paperwork that may aid you in receiving needed assistance.
- Preferred hospital, primary care provider contact information, medical equipment contact, home health provider contact, etc.
- Veterinary care information for your pets/service animal
- Any church-related information such as baptism certificate, temple recommend, Bishop's contact information, etc.)
