I. Romans 8:1-4 - The blessings from walking in the spirit.

- A. Freedom from condemnation.
- B. Freedom from the law of sin and death.
- C. The righteousness of the law is fulfilled in us.

II. Romans 8:5-8 - The result of being carnally minded.

- A. The carnal mind is focused on the flesh.
- B. The carnal mind is enmity against God and results in death.
- C. The carnal mind is not subject to the law of God.

III. Romans 8:9-14 - When we walk after the Spirit:

- A. The Spirit will dwell in us.
- B. To be spiritually minded is to have life and peace.
- C. The Spirit will help us to mortify the deeds of the body.
- D. We will be sons of God.

IV. Romans 8:15-25 - Those who walk after the Spirit are heirs.

- A. The Spirit bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.
- B. If we are children, we are heirs of God and joint-heirs with Christ.
- C. We may suffer, but it is not compared to the glory of sonship.
- D. The whole creation awaits the deliverance from corruption.
- E. As children, we have hope, which is a basis of salvation.

V. Romans 8:26-39 - God is on our side.

- A. The Spirit will help us with our prayers.
- B. All things work together for good to them that love God.
- C. God showed His love and care for us in giving His Son.
- D. We are more than conquerors through Christ
- E. Nothing outside self can separate us from the love of God.
