

# **COURSE INFORMATION**

This course is designed to both mentally and physically prepare you, as a motor officer, to operate a police motorcycle while performing a variety of law enforcement duties safety and effectively. Extensive time will be utilized by the course instructors towards building your skill level as well as your confidence level when riding a police motorcycle.

#### **PRE-TRAINING:**

It is <u>highly recommended</u> that officers have pre-training to start the course. M.T.I. offers one-on-one pre-training if needed.

## **REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:**

- Helmet property fastened and D.O.T. approved, eye protection and full-fingered gloves
- Uniform (BDU/TDU style pants and long sleeve t-shirt) and Boots (must be over the ankle, rigid non-slip sole)
- Duty vest and duty belt for range day
- 200 rounds of pistol ammunition (if your agency deploys a rifle or shotgun from the motorcycle, bring an additional 25 rounds for that firearm)
- Bring sunscreen, hat/baseball cap and rain gear
- Agency motorcycle required: motorcycles will be inspected by instructors to ensure they
  function safely. (i.e. proper tire tread, brakes, etc.) (\*Note: motorcycles will be stored/secured
  at training facility. If students are permitted to commute to and from class via department
  motorcycle, a written letter of authorization must be provided.)
