DESCRIPTION: This course is designed to provide experienced motorcycle officers (student instructor) with the knowledge, skills and proficiency to safely instruct aspiring motorcycle enforcement officers. The course curriculum strongly emphasizes teaching safe and competent operation of the police motorcycle while paying particular attention to acceptable standards of rider capabilities and judgement.

This course consists of lectures and hands-on/practical skills training. Student instructors will provide hand on instruction of new motor officers. They will be exposed to evaluating and testing new motor officers and correcting any deficiencies.

Learning activities include: Inspection of motorcycle for safety functions, street cone patterns, off-road cone patterns, stop practical's and off-road course practice. Methods for assessing learning: Skills evaluation and test on cone patterns and motorcycle stops to be graded by instructors using P.O.S.T. standards.

INSTRUCTORS: Instructors are P.O.S.T. certified and veteran officers with a wide range of knowledge and experience.

PREREQUISITE: All students MUST have completed the P.O.S.T. Basic Motorcycle Course. M1 Endorsement, MUST be a full time/part time law enforcement officer.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT: Students MUST have the following: 1) Certified D.O.T. motorcycle helmet & shatter resistant eye protection 2) Department Utility Uniform (coverall/DBU's) 3) Over the ankle boots and leather gloves 4) Agency motorcycle
