### **USF Conducted 'Believe or not' event.**

Today marks a special day for the Deep Space Industry as multiple significant events took place across the globe. Religious rites and ceremonies were performed in several countries, including India where a strong Abhishek puja involving USF officials was conducted. Coincidentally, today also marks the 50th birthday of a renowned astronaut.

In an undisclosed location, an event was held that unveiled the new shape of the deep space market. This event showcased several key developments in the industry that are set to transform the future of space exploration.

The following are some key takeaways from the event:

1. Event-2001 is set to take place in June, and it is expected to involve significantly more resources compared to Event-201 for pandemic drills. The event is based on a model of a pandemic originating from deep space due to long human missions from Earth.

3. Deep space is set to be militarized quickly.
4. Private missions to the Moon are set to be announced later this year, with 7 BFRs transporting 90 humans for periods of 1-3-6 months on the surface.
5. The Exchange will allow astronauts to be traded similar to football players.
6. The number of MPH passports (Multiplanetary humans) is limited to 1.1 billion.
7. SpaceGames might replace the Olympic Games.
8. The US patent office has granted a patent to the cornerstone of Deep Space Medicine, developed in Spain.
9. Spain has established its own Space Agency with a budget of EUR 0.7 billion for the first year.
10. An RFP for 12 astronauts will be published with a total budget of USD 12.8 million.
11. USF Population health contracts have been signed for 5 countries.
12. A fresh declassified report from NASA claims 510 registered cases of UFO sightings.

The Deep Space Industry is on the cusp of a new era, with these developments marking significant strides in the advancement of space exploration. These events demonstrate the growing interest and investment in space exploration, which will undoubtedly shape the future of human existence.
