

## **ORCC WGA Meeting Day Minutes**

February 25, 2025

## 1. Suzi Good:

- a. Meeting called to order by Suzi Good at 1:00pm.
- b. Thanks to Cathy Gies for the great event, food, game etc.
- c. Welcome to new member, Aya Ito. She is a fantastic player and Suzi is recruiting her for team play.
