Here are some of the updates: Barb Baldassano was recognized for doing a fantastic job in spearheading the social events. Fixing ball marks on our greens is still a huge problem. The board is thinking about having to assign people to holes as they've done in the past. If you see a divot, please fix it. The board also asked that everyone pair up when taking a cart. If they see a foursome with three carts and no one is sharing, each person will be charged \$48. Or two carts with one person both will pay \$48. There are new practice range balls.
