

VESSEL RENTAL ORIENTATION CHECKLIST

BOAT

Life Jacket Requirements and Safety Equipment

- You must have one wearable life jacket for each person on board vessel.
- Children under age 13 must wear a life jacket while on a moving vessel, except inside a closed cabin.
- Life jacket must be the appropriate size and in good working condition.
- Life jackets must be readily accessible and NOT stored in a locked compartment.
- You must have one throwable ring buoy or square cushion on all vessels over 16' in length.
- You must have a fire extinguisher on all vessels with gas tank.
- You must have an observer or wide angle mirror to tow skiers.
- You must have navigation lights on during hours of darkness or low visibility.














- You must wear an appropriate personal flotation device (PFD) at all times while operating a PWC.
- Securely attach engine shut-off cord (lanyard) to your wrist or PFD (as directed) and wear it at all times. Then if you fall off the PWC, the engine will stop.
- Stopping the engine will not stop the forward motion of the PWC and will result in loss of steering.
- The throttle controls your speed. Without thrust you cannot steer the PWC.
- Only tow skiers with a 3 person PWC. You must have an observer on board to watch skier.
- PWC's are NOT allowed to operate during hours of darkness. Sunset today is at _
- Must be 12 years old to operate a PWC with Boat Education card **OR** with an adult.

Do Not Release Throttle when trying to Steer


- You need throttle to steer.
- Remember, PWC's and other boats do not have brakes.
- Keep 100 feet away from people, objects and other boats.

- Scan constantly for people, objects and other boats on the water.
- Be alert for conditions that limit your visibility or block your vision of others
- Vessels on your right have the right of way, slow down and let them pass.
- Vessels approaching head on should pass each other on the right side safely.
- If you pass another vessel, allow enough room in case vessel makes a turn.
- Motorboats must yield to non-powered vessels, like a sail boat or canoe.

Boat Sober Don't Drink and Drive Boating Under the Influence

- Using alcohol, drugs and prescription medication may impair my ability to operate this boat safely.
- I will not operate this boat or allow anyone else to operate this boat while under the influence.
- I understand that a skier or person on a tube can be arrested for skiing under the influence.

Operator Responsibility

- Operate at a safe speed. NO horseplay or reckless operation while operating a vessel.
- Keep 100 feet away from people, objects and other boats if operating over idle speed.
- Do not jump wakes or waves around other vessels or persons in the water.
- Operate on the right side of narrow river channels or blind spots.
- Slow NO WAKE means idle speed!
- Must be 16 years old to operate any vessel 16 feet and longer, and must have a picture ID.
- Anyone born after January 1, 1998 must complete a Boat Education Course before operating a vessel.

Nottely Marina Rules & Information

- Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to reserved time. Return vessel to the dock 15 minutes prior to end of reservation time to unload, refuel, and check out.
- Cancellations made within 48 hours of reservation time or "no-shows" will be charged \$150 cancellation fee to billing information provided by Lessee. Lessee authorizes Marina to charge billing information on file for any charges, rates, fees, or damages incurred related to said use of vessel, equipment, and/or accessories. CANCELLATIONS MUST BE MADE BY PHONE or IN PERSON.
- Lessee has accepted vessel, equipment, and accessories in current, acceptable, and satisfactory condition and will return to the Marina said vessel, equipment, and accessories in the same condition in which it departed the Marina.
- Lessee must return vessel, equipment, and accessories free of mud, dirt, clay, rocks, and/or debris. If vessel is returned to Marina excessively dirty, muddy, stained, or with debris on board, Lessee agrees to be charged a \$150 additional cleaning fee. Normal and usual dirtiness is expected, it is, also, expected the vessel, equipment, and accessories be maintained in the condition in which it was released to Lessee.
- For loss or damages to electronics, vinyl, safety equipment, accessories, or any part of said vessel; Lessee will be charged retail cost of the damaged item plus all costs of installation. Afore mentioned loss or damages to said vessel, equipment, or accessories will be charged to Lessee as out-of-pocket expenses. Lessee is responsible for any loss or damages to vessel, equipment, or accessories while in Lessee's possession.
- > Do not damage propeller (prop.) \$300 prop replacement cost. \$150 trolling motor prop replacement cost.
- Pets are welcome aboard. \$25 pet fee per vessel. Please have pets leashed while on Marina property, parking areas, docks, and shorelines.
- ➤ Be courteous: Return vessel, equipment, and accessories to Marina 15 minutes prior to end of reservation time. A late return fee \$30 for every 30 minutes Lessee and/or their drivers are late will be charged to Lessee's billing information on file. Lessee agrees to return vessel, equipment, and accessories clean and unloaded to Marina by the stated return time.
- Vessel fuel tank is full upon Lessee's departure and Lessee is responsible for fuel usage upon return to Marina. Do not venture further than time or fuel allows. Lessee is responsible for allowing sufficient margin of time for contingencies. SAFETY WARNING: Gasoline is extremely flammable and highly explosive under certain conditions.
- > Lessee understands there are no refunds, credits, rate adjustment or compensation for late arrivals or early returns.
- Lessee and/or their driver's must be 21 years of age or older and have present at check-in a valid government issued driver's license.
- > 24 hours, multi-day, and weekly rates are charged rental rate at check-in. Fuel usage is charged upon return or as needed.
- Do not beach vessels. Do not run vessel aground for any reason. Life threatening injuries and serious damages can occur to pontoons, hull, engine, equipment, passengers, property, and others nearby.
- Lessee agrees said vessel, equipment, and/or accessories shall not be occupied by more than the posted U.S.C.G max rated person/weight capacity at any time.
- Lessee agrees to report any equipment and/or accessories lost, broken, stolen, or damaged and may subsequently be charged for said items.
- > Rental vessels and/or equipment may not be operated after sunset or before sunrise.
- Lessee and/or drivers are personally financially responsible for any damages their wake may cause.
- No grills or cooking appliances permitted on aboard vessels.
- Minor children or those in the custody of Lessee and/or their guests must always be accompanied by a responsible adult. No running or rough play while around water, on docks, or Marina property.
- Lessee, their driver's, and/or guests must follow all applicable laws and regulations regarding vessel operation and shall not operate vessel in a negligent or reckless manner and shall not operate vessel, equipment, and/or accessories while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Lessee, their driver's, and/or guests understand the use of Marina property, docks, parking areas, restrooms, buildings, vessels, equipment, and/or accessories is strictly **USE AT YOUR OWN RISK** and they voluntarily accept those risks either known or unknown risks. All guests must act in a manner that is reasonable, customary, and mindful of surroundings and the well being of others in mind.
- You are in the mountains and weather forecasts are highly inaccurate. **The Marina has no more control over the weather than you do.** Keep in mind, it may rain at some point during your visit. Assume there is always a possibility of rain, sun, wind, and/or thunderstorms.

Nottely Marina does not require a down payment, advance payment, or advance security deposit to make a reservation. However, we ask customers to return the courtesy by agreeing to pay for the rental time reserved and give more than 48 hours cancellation notice.
