Our classes are all suited to each age level to be appropriate both in skill level and maturity. In the instance where an age level overlaps, we will assess each student to see which level they will best fit into. Preschool, Mini, Junior and Adult classes are 45mins in length.

Advanced classes are open to anyone over the age of 14. These are targeted towards experienced dancers.

Adult classes are strictly 18+. These classes are casual with the option of performing at the end of year concert. No experience required, and classes are suited to the individual students.



Ballet is the foundation for all styles of dance. Technique, strength, posture and flexibility are all consistently improved through weekly ballet training.

Kicks, Turns, Jumps and leaps all come together to create this upbeat and challenging style. Covering all forms of jazz from commercial, to broadway!

Although the two styles are different in their own ways, they are both derived from ballet. With a big emphasis on expression and emotion, this is a fantastic style to perform.

A popular street style of dance using poping, isolations, and freedom of movement to mostly RnB songs.

Using Poms and a variety of Jazz skills, this popular style really gets the heartrate up! A huge focus on arm lines and uniformity in this style.

Competition Teams

We are so excited to offer competition teams for all age groups in 2025!

Any student wishing to join a Jazz and Lyrical, or Pom Team must do their compulsory ballet ballet and recreational class in each style. This ensures every team member is at the same skill level, and technique is kept at the highest standard.

Class attendance is critical for competition teams. No more than 2 classes may be missed per term (Exceptions made for serious illness and family emergencies) Excessive absences will result in discussion of removal from the team.

Competition Teams will compete 4-6 times per year (depending on age group and comp availability). All competition dates are compulsory and will be finalised in Term 1.

Competition classes do incur additional costs, such as costumes, entry fees, training, music etc.

A full comprehensive invoice will be provided in Term 1. Please speak to us for any further info.

Recreational Classes

We offer recreational classes for all ages and styles (excluding Pom). Recreational classes are a great option if you want to dance, but not compete.

Recreational classes require full attendance in term 4 if you wish to perform in the end of year concert.

All our recreational classes focus on learning new skills in a fun environment.

Compulsory Dates:

Policies

We do have some compulsory dates for all students throughout the year.

Specific dates will be set ASAP and all students and parents will be notified.

Term 4 - Photo Day, End of Year Concert, Awards Day

Costumes:

All students taking part in the end of year concert will need to hire a costume for each style. \$50 for the first costume, \$25 for additional costumes. This is accompanied by a performance fee to cover venue hire.

Solo and Duo students may choose to hire a costume for the above cost, or outsource their own (with approval from their teacher). Our owner Lyndsay creates custom costumes if you wish to purchase a custom one.

Strict No Bullying Policy:

Studio 22 will not allow bullying of any kind. Bullying/harassment will be handled in a serious and timely manner. There is a zero tolerance approach for discrimination here as well. Studio 22 is a safe space for all, and we will keep it that way!

Payment Terms

Studio 22 will do what we can to make payment options easy for our customers, however we do expect timely payments.

Terms fees are due at the start of each term. All term fees must be paid upfront, or via Direct Debit on a weekly or fortnightly basis. Payment plans must be organised before your first class.

Refunds will only be given if a cancellation is made within 7 days of initial payment, minus any classes (attended or not) in that 7 day period. Any other refunds are at managements discretion.

Credits will be applied where a class is cancelled, and no makeup class is offered(excluding hot/wild weather policy). No credits, refunds or makeup classes will be given for a student missing class for their own reasons.

Extreme Weather/Hot Weather

Classes will not run if outside temperature exceeds 34 Degrees, or a Severe Weather alert is in effect - an email will be sent to all parents and we will update our social media in this instance. This is in the best interest of students & staff as our factory can get quite hot & dancing in these conditions is not only unpleasant, but also unsafe. We will make every effort to provide replacement classes in the case of Extreme Heat. No refunds or credits are entitled in this situation. Classes will be modified for temperatures over 30 Degrees.

Injury/Illness Policies

If any injury/issue occurs where 1st Aid attention was administered to a student (even just applying an icepack) an injury report will be filled out by a member of staff. A copy will be sent home with the student. Should an injury require an ambulance to be called, parents hereby agree to Studio 22 requesting the ambulance on your child's behalf.

If a student has an injury or illness they are managing in class they must let management and their teacher know in writing before the class begins. Students with injuries or minor illness(non-contagious) are encouraged to still attend class to watch as to not fall behind their class/team. Students with serious or ongoing injuries must bring a note from a parent/guardian & full Medical/Physio Certificate stating what they can & cannot do in class. Allstar Dance Competitive Teams require a full Medical/Physio Certificate of illness/Injury if it results in an absence.

Photography and Social Media

All Students agree to having their photos taken and used on social media and advertising upon enrolment. If you wish to exclude your child from this, you must let us know.

Any student, parent or other person affiliated with Studio 22 found to be portraying Studio 22 in a negative light on Social Media will be asked to remove any media and may result in removal from the studio.
