LOCATION OF MATCHES:

Felipe Tennis and Recreation Center 27161 Nogal, Mission Viejo CA 92630 Phone: 949-859-4348, option 5

PARKING:

Direct parking in lot and street parking adjacent to the center are available. (GREEN ON MAP)

Please do not block residential homes and be a good neighbor.

Should the lot and street parking fill up, overflow parking is available via short walk from the Carl Hankey School. (AQUA ON MAP)

ARRIVE EARLY:

Start times for divisions are FIRM. 15 minutes prior to the start of your division, the Tournament Director will announce court assignments and review scoring rules. Players are then to proceed to

courts to warm up and be prepared to start the round-robin matches. PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE. Check-in should be completed 30 minutes prior to the start of your match.

MEALS:

Each player will receive a complementary meal ticket at check-in, good for one of the following items.

Complementary wristbands will be given to each player. **ONLY PLAYERS** are allowed on the courts apart from tournament personnel and staff. Please make sure you wear your wristband (GREEN).

All players will be asked to complete a liability waiver at check in. A copy of the waiver is attached to this packet if you would like to fill it out prior to your arrival and bring it completed with you to expedite check-in.

If you are a club member and have a waiver on file, you do not need to bring another one.

Our event is spectator friendly and we have an ample outdoor patio area for players and guests to mingle and watch some fantastic pickleball. Tickets for raffle baskets may be purchased at check-in with CASH or CREDIT CARD. Tickets are \$5 each.



PBALL COURT ACCESS:

Enter through gate 5 adjacent to Pickleball Court 1 for courts 1-4.

Enter through gate 6 adjacent to Pickleball Court 5 for courts 5 & 6.

Overflow courts 7, 8, 9, 10 are accessible through gate 3 & 4 at the back of the patio.

All courts have painted lines (no tape) and semi permanent tournament rated pickeball nets.

Additional courts will be available for warming up through Gate 1 and 2.



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Division Draws and Scoring

All Round Robin Matches are subject to a 20 min time limit. Once all games have finished, there will be a 10 minute break for players to enter in their scores, grab water, and switch to their next court assignment.

Each division will have a different amount of round-robin matches depending on the number of players in the division. Additional games will be played for playoffs and finals.

We are PRIORITIZING WINS over POINTS. Points will be used to determine ties in bracket placements, so please enter them correctly.

Scoring:

All games are first to 11, win by 2, or the team with the most points at the 20 minute time marker.

Time Reminders will be announced 15 minutes into game play, and 18 minutes into the match if games are still in progress.

The 18 minute time marker, is the **two (2) min. final warning**, Each side may call only one, (1) minute break during the 20 minute play period. No breaks may be called after the 2 minute time warning has been called.

Winning team should record the match scores into the swish app.

How to handle ties when time limit is called:

If the score is 10-8 at the time marker, the team leading the score will take the win.


If teams are tied (10-10, 8-8 etc) and time is called, **THE BALL IS STILL LIVE. Continue to play the point until the ball either goes out of bounds, someone has a foot fault into the kitchen, or the ball is not returned by the opposing team.** Whoever successfully ends the rally would take the win for the match... even if they are not the serving team.

Examples:

- The team who last returned the ball in the boundary play lines when the opposing team misses the shot would take the match.
- The team who does not conduct a foot fault in the final rally by stepping into the kitchen to hit a live ball if the other team does, would take the win.






