




Importing Images into Carlson Office

Aerial and other imagery can be easily attached to the any CAD drawing using the following instructional steps.

Instructional Steps:

- 1. Open a new drawing.
- 2. Type the command "Image" which loads the Image Manager dialog box
- 3. Click the "attach" button which loads the Attach Image dialog box
- 4. Browse to the location where image stored and select desired image (.jpg)



- 5. Ensure that the "Use positioning file" box is checked
- 6. Verify the insertion point, scale, and rotation are correct. (if the image has been orthorectified the software will recognize this and show the correct x and y coordinates for the insertion point) If everything appears to be correct click the OK button.
- 7. The Image Manager dialog box will appear again populated by the soon to be attached image data. Verify all information and preview are correct and click the OK button.
- 8. A zoom extents will often need to be initiated to allow the image to be seen.

Best Practice:

It is often helpful to show aerial imagery faded such that drawing elements can be easily seen with the image draw order set back. Recommend 50% fade.
