

Stained Glass Block Class

Supplies:

- 1) 8 fat quarters or bring multiple fabrics at least 10" x 10". Each block created needs a minimum of 8 different colors. Please press all fabric before class
- 2) 1 3/4 yards black for framing strips (or color of choice)
- 3) mat and rotary cutter with new blade
- 4) square grid ruler for squaring up your blocks (bigger is always better)
- 5) general sewing supplies
- 6) pencil

If you have one, this is a great time to bring your cutting machines to class for making the 1 inch framing strips. Also, a June Taylor type cutting ruler works well for cutting multiple 1" strips.

You will be creating your own project pattern with paper (provided). You might want to think about making a table piece or a Christmas tree skirt with your blocks. You can use this idea to create Christmas stockings or use the blocks in a clothing pattern. The ideas are endless! It doesn't have to finish out as a quilt. Bias tape will not be used. You will learn how to insert 1" strips between your stained glass pieces to create a finished block.
