Supplies:

Go get grandma's hankies, dresser scarves, tatting, lace, etc. You will be cutting these pieces up to fit into your design so bring your anxiety meds if needed!

Lightweight iron on stabilizer if your linens are very thin.

If you have a crocheted pot holder that looks like a flower pot, bring

that also. Otherwise I will show you how to create a container using some of your linens.

Any type of background fabric that you like. I used simple solids that I thought coordinated with the antique theme of my quilt. You will be making squares/rectangles to sew your laces onto so the lace should look nice against your chosen fabric. This fabric will also be used to border your blocks.

I also used some plain white hankies for the more open space behind my floral arrangement but you could easily use something else.

rulers and square templates to easily square up your created blocks
