






Activity 1-


Help Yousif find his way home for Iftaar. Chose this opportunity to talk to children about Iftaar and why we fast during Ramadan



Teach children why Ramadan is so important and why they should embrace it. Emphasise the importance of family and the spirit of giving during this holy month.




Help everyone in the family – young and old find their way to Tarawih Prayers in the Mosque.




Connect the dots to reveal the picture






Activity 19: Color and accessorize this beautiful Ramadan design




Activity 20:
