### IACC JANUARY ELECTIONS

The IACC elections for the terms for 2026-2027 will be held on Tuesday, January 20 at St. Veronica's Falcon Hall. As with ever year, elections steer the course of the club into the future.

This year's positions up for election include president, treasurer, one trustees position and six board positions. Adding to some confusion to the process is that no nominations were made for the president's position and only five nominations were received for the six board spots.

This opened the door to a process in the Club's bylaws where motions were made and were seconded at the November General Meeting to have individuals that are termed out to serve additional terms. Motions were made for three individuals for the Board positions and only one can fill the one non-nominated position.

Where the confusion comes in is that the elections will be in two parts. One, as a normal voting process where the membership will vote on those nominated for their respective positions. On a second and separate portion will be the membership voting to ratify the motions for the president and the one remaining board position.

Once again, the motions were seconded and voted on at the November General Meeting. A simple majority of the members present at the January General Meeting will be needed to ratify the motions made.

As always, it is highly recommended that all members attend and exercise their right to vote and have a voice in who holds these important roles for the next two years.


