As we continue to set up more events for our members and friends, we are planning to continue our inhouse Italian Festa, which will be held on Sunday, August 20 in celebration of Ferragosto. The celebration of Ferragosto began with Augustus Caesar and was proclaimed as a celebration of the end of the harvest season and days of rest. This event continues to be celebrated every August in Italy to this day.

In addition to our many in-house Bocce Leagues, the Parks & Recreation Department will once again have an open Bocce League for the Summer beginning on July 13. We will also be hosting several organization's bocce tournaments that I feel are inspiring and opens our Club and the courts to the community.

With that said, the IACC has entered into a partnership with the City of South San Francisco and in cooperation with the Lucchesi nel Mondo Association, the California Law Enforcement Columbia Association and Le Donne d'Italia to hold a Festa Italiana on Sunday, September 24 in Orange Memorial Park. We are exploring every option that is available and I am eager to see our members embrace this new celebration. Our Vice President, Adam Elsibai, will be our point person and will work with Sharon (Tarantino) Meagher, who is graciously assisting us with the many city agencies we will be dealing with.

Once again, I hope all is well with our members and friends and I hope to see you at our President's Social on April 28 and at the General Meeting on May 16.




Ronald McDonald Houses


