NOTICE: The Orange Memorial Park Bocce Courts are city-owned property with supervision of use granted to the South Francisco Italian American Citizens Club (IACC) through the Co-Sponsored Organization Agreement with the City of South San Francisco. All private use of the facilities must be approved by the Parks and Recreation Department by way of an executed Facility Use Permit after filing this application with the IACC. A permit fee will be assessed (\$93), payable to the City of South San Francisco as well as a flat rate per court use. Permits are issued by appointment at the Parks and Recreation Department office located at 901 Civic Campus Way (LPR)

2. A member of the IACC will meet you at the designated time at the bocce courts for entry and will be responsible for the supervision and adherence to these Court Rules.
3. A voluntary donation is appreciated for the maintenance of the grounds and an assessment is asked for the use of IACC equipment.
4. Organizations/Groups are responsible for cleaning up the area once the event is over.

COURT RULES

1. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the facility without usage permit issued by the Parks and Recreation Department indicating alcohol is permitted. In the event alcohol is sold or included in the cost of admission, an alcohol sales permit must be obtained from the SSF Police Department and the California Alcohol Beverage Control Department (ABC). The ABC permit must be displayed in a visible location.
2. No smoking of any type is allowed anywhere within the park (SSF Municipal Code 8.50.030)
3. No beverages, food, cups or plates allowed on or around the playing bocce courts and are not to be dropped in surrounding areas. Please dispose of them in the trash receptacles or recycle bins.
4. No chairs, benches or tables are to be placed on the bocce courts.
5. Children are to be supervised at all times and are not allowed to walk, run on or about the bocce courts or to play on the bocce courts with their hands, sticks or other items.
6. No shoes with pointed heels are permitted on the bocce courts. Only flat tennis-type shoes allowed.
7. No pets, other than service animals, are allowed on the bocce courts or in the entire Club area.
8. No abusive language to be used on and around the bocce courts. Be courteous and treat everyone in a positive manner. Note that some events will only be using certain bocce courts and others may also be on site.
9. No alterations or modifications to the bocce courts are allowed.
10. Proper manner of dress is required.

BOCCE COURTS AND FACILITY USE APPLICATION (cont.)

- 11. Anyone disturbing or disrupting either a game or reception is subject to expulsion from the premises.
- 12. IACC area to be vacated no later than 5 PM.
- 13. Prior to vacating the premises, cleaning of the ENTIRE area is the responsibility of the using organization/group.

NOTE: The bocce courts are a professional sports arena and are utilized for leagues and tournaments throughout the year. They are maintained by volunteers and the surface is sensitive and is to be used for only bocce play. If damage is done to the bocce courts or its surface, an assessment will be made for materials needed to make repairs and assessed to the utilizing organization/group.
