**HISTORY:** The South San Francisco Italian American Citizens Club was founded on December 7, 1916 by a group of concerned immigrants. They founded a political organization as an incentive for Italian immigrants to become citizens. Today, the organization is no longer political, and non-Italian members are welcome. The IACC continues to foster and maintain the values of the founders in being committed to the betterment of the community.

**SOCIAL EVENTS:** The IACC hosts several social events throughout the year: Crab Feed Dinner, Festa Italiana, Membership Dinner, Person of the Year Holiday Dinner Dance, and other fun events.

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** The IACC awards two scholarships annually to deserving high school seniors.

**DONATIONS:** The IACC supports Cooley's Anemia research, Samaritan House, One Warm Coat, and Safe Harbor.

**NEWSLETTER:** Our newsletter called "IL CITTADINO" is sent to all members every other month. It features articles and pictures and keeps the members up-to-date on all of the IACC events.

**MEETINGS:** All members are encouraged to attend our General Membership meetings which are held on the third Tuesday of each odd month.

**BOCCE:** The indoor and outdoor courts were built in 1989, through the shared financial support of both the City of South San Francisco and the Italian American Citizens Club. Members maintain the six Bocce courts at Orange Memorial Park in South San Francisco. The courts are open to the public during posted days & hours.

**As an IACC member,** you may participate in our very popular Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter Bocce Leagues, as well as play in club Tournaments which are held throughout the year. Members and their friends/families may also enjoy the courts during park's posted hours.
