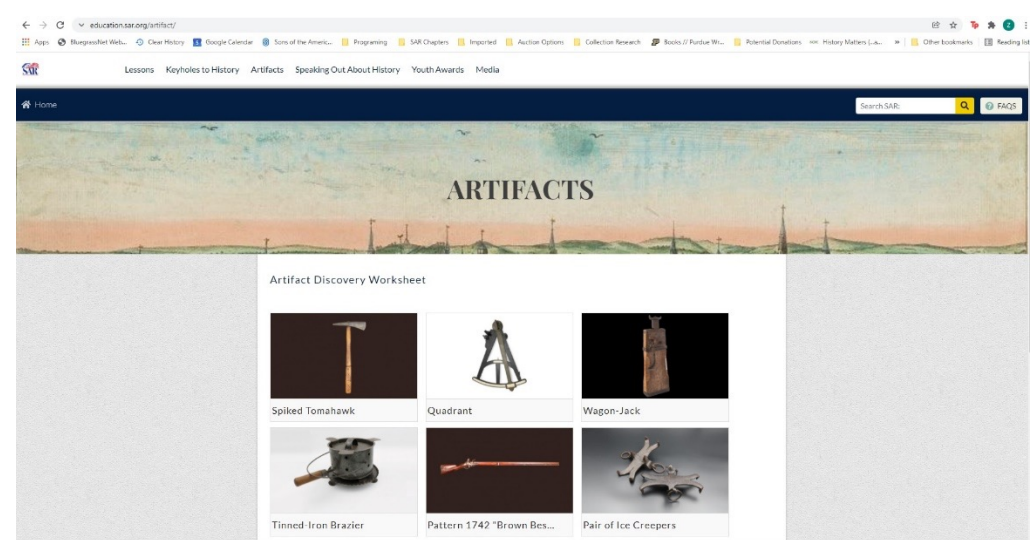




- Each artifact is given an accession number for tracking and to maintain records, donor information, and provenance

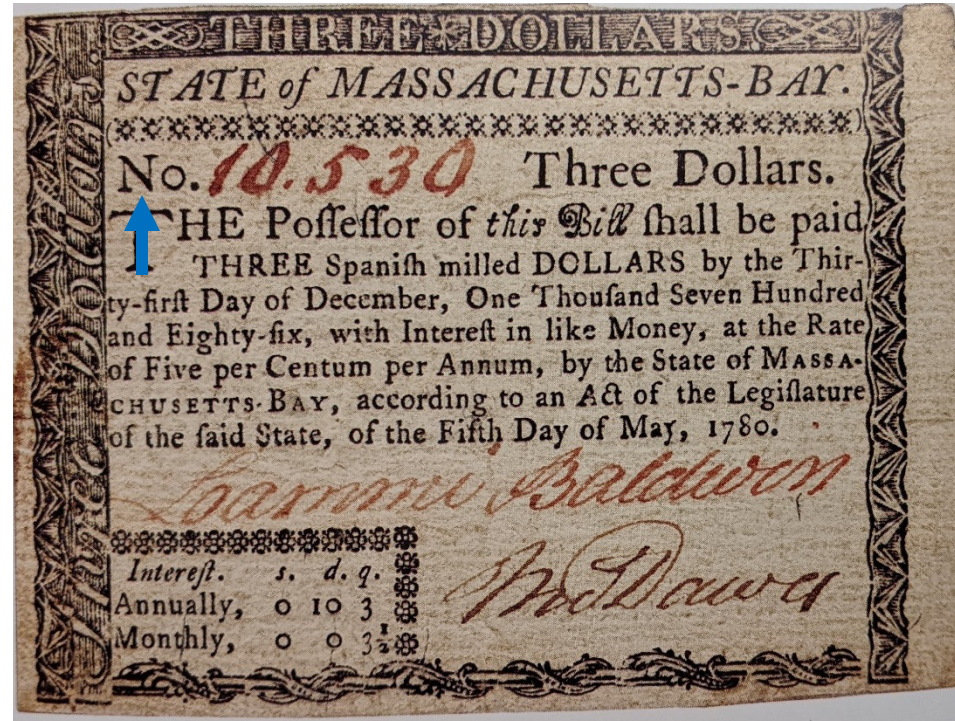

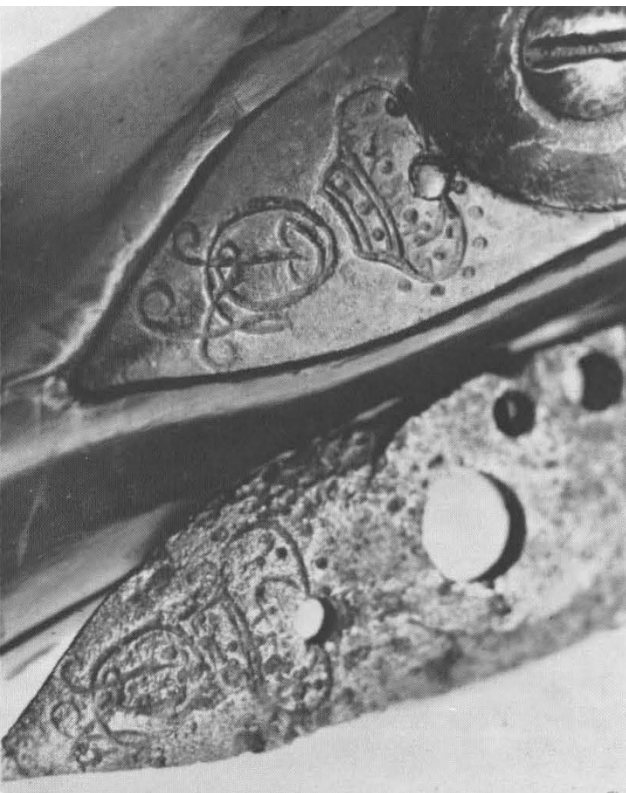
