About the Chapter

The General Richard Montgomery Chapter was chartered in 1955, and is located in Montgomery, Alabama, serving members in and around the Central Alabama area. The Chapter is named in honor of Major General Richard Montgomery, an Irish American soldier who served in the Continental Army during the Revolutionary War. He was the first General Officer killed in the Revolutionary War, while leading the Canadian Expedition as they pushed on to Quebec with barely 800 strong. An assault was made on the 31st of December 1775, and almost at the first discharge of fire, General Montgomery was killed.
