Service Details and Pricing

Weekly or Bi-weekly Pool Maintenance Service

Weekly (\$85.00 & up) per week & Bi-weekly (\$125 & up) per service

Service Details Services Included

- Clean skimmer and pump baskets
- Check pool equipment for proper operation
- Skim and vacuum pool
- Backwash filter when necessary
- Test for chemical balance and adjust if necessary (Chemicals are billed at an additional charge)
- Brush pool when needed

Weekly Pool Chemical Check

Weekly Chemical ONLY Check \$55.00 Per week

This is for customers who do not want weekly cleaning service but want their chemicals checked and balanced

Service Details Services Include

- Clean skimmer and pump baskets
- Test for chemical balance and adjust if necessary (Chemicals are billed at an additional charge)

Service Calls and repairs:

Service calls are \$275 due at scheduling service

Service Includes

- Service call fee includes up to 1 hour of labor and diagnostics.
- All parts are additional billed a standard industry pricing.
- If the repair is going to exceed \$550.00 in parts and labor a written quote will be supplied for customer approvals
- Additional labor/diagnostics is billed at \$165.00 per Man Hour

Spring Opening Service:

Spring Opening (\$350 & up)

Service Includes

- Removal of Cover-If you have a tarp-style cover with water bags and there is water or debris on top when we come to open the pool, an additional charge will apply.
- Folding of Cover-and placing by poolside (We do not put cover away unless prior arrangements are made; we recommend allowing cover to dry before storing for summer.)
- Initial Chemical Treatment (chlorine & algicide) This is not a complete balance of water chemistry.
- Operational Check of Pool Equipment- If any equipment fails to operate, customer will be informed and sent a quote for repairs
- Re-installation of Accessories (ladders, handrails, etc.)
- Storing Winterization Plugs in a plastic bag left poolside by the cover
- Opening Spa attached to pool (additional \$125.00)

Pre-Opening Notes:

- Water level must be at least to the mid-skimmer; if too low, a return visit will be scheduled, and a \$65.00 trip charge will be added to the service.
- Pool opening does not include initial cleaning
- Ensure outside water access is turned on at the time of service

Pool Closing & Winterization

Winterizing Service Includes (\$350 & up)

- Lowering water level
- Draining the filter, pump, and heater
- Adding chemicals
- Removing ladders and handrails
- Blowing out and plugging all pool lines
(If plugs are rotted or missing, new winterizing plugs will be provided at an additional cost)
- Storing all return fittings ETC. in a plastic bag near pool equipment
- Installing pool cover

Pre-Closing Notes

- Leave your pool cover, winter plugs out on closing day poolside or by the equipment
- If we must come back or retrieve the pool cover, there will be an \$65 Trip return fee
- All items removed will be left by the pool equipment unless prior arrangements are made
- Pool must be clean, no leaves or debris, for us to close (Cleaning is not included with closing)
- Ensure outside water is on for filter cleaning

Pricing & Payment, Invoicing

- Pricing can vary based on pool size, condition, and selected add-ons
- All fees are subject to **NJ State Sales Tax**
- Out of scope work will be billed at \$165.00 per Man hour
