COLORADO WAlleye Trail HOW TO ENTER A FISH

STEP #1 Take Measurement Pic




This pic MUST INCLUDE and CLEARLY SHOW :

- Mouth/nose of fish touching the bump end of the measuring board
- The tail pinched to show longest measurement of the fish (inches side)
- The Scorecard <u>PRIOR</u> to documenting the fish

For the best pics and to ensure confirmation of your catch:

- Move measuring board to full sunlight to avoid shadows and take from directly above (as shown in pic)
- Make sure camera is focused for a clear shot. Check pic and re-take if needed, before going to next step

STEP #2 Shoot Release Video



The Video MUST SHOW:

- The fish being lifted off the measuring board and released into the water
 For best video results:
 - Make sure the timer is counting on your video. Confirm with partner before releasing the the fish

STEP #3 Take Scorecard Pic



The Scorecard pic MUST SHOW:

- The time the fish was caught
- The length of the fish (including the 1/4" round up)

Scorecard is used for final confirmation:

- Fill out Scorecard after the fish has been released
- DO NOT fill out the wieght portion of the scorecard
- Bring your completed scorecard along with the phone containing all pics and videos to the weight tent for final confirmation of your daily basket

STEP #4 Text All 3 Elements The text must include:

- Boat # and the fish # for each set of elements for each fish
- The Measurement Pic, Release Video and Scorecard Pic for the corresponding fish

Helpful Tips:

- DO NOT DELETE any pics or videos until after the event is over
- Take a "black" pic of your hand between different fish to help stay organized in your library
