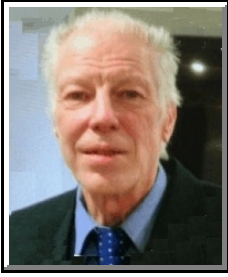

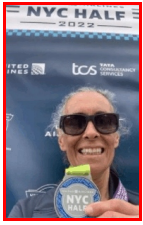
One petition was voted on for affiliation from W. Brian Scott Finger.
