### CHAPTER SAFETY RULES/ GUIDELINES

- 1.) **Chapter Safety Officer** shall be responsible for safety at all events sponsored by our Chapter. He will insure all safety rules are complied with and direct the safe operation of all antique fire apparatus.
- 2.) **Chapter Safety Officer** shall be Chairman of the Safety Committee which will determine the following:
  - \* The adequate number of Safety Officials needed per event
  - \* Assure Safety Officials are properly identified during event.
  - \* Supply each Safety Official with a plan of action in the event of a medical emergency, accident, or severe weather condition.
- 3.) All apparatus participating in event will be required to do the following:
  - \* Have Apparatus brakes set during static display.
  - \* Rear wheels chocked (Fore & Aft )
  - \* Have at least one serviceable 10BC fire extinguisher
  - \* Have someone attending Apparatus at all times.
- 4.) **Chapter Safety Officer** will insure all applicable **SPAAMFAA** Safety Rules and Guidelines SP-01,SP-02,SP-03, SP-04, SP-05, SP-06, shall be complied with during any Chapter sponsored events.
