Francis Schaeffer’s *How Should We Then Live?* is a wonderful, thoughtful book. It is a challenge to us all.

*How Should We Then Give?* is a challenge as well, a poignant question demanding answers and action. God’s Word provides much instruction regarding giving. I have often asked myself whether or not I have taken His commands regarding giving seriously. For before being sentenced to a 30-year prison term, I’d been a “big giver” to the church and considered myself generous with my income and property. But was I giving in accordance with God’s will? I think not.


For nearly 14 years, I’ve lived in a prison cell. The prison pays me about \$40 a month

to work in the carpentry shop. I earn a modest amount helping other inmates with their legal work. Friends and family

have been generous to give me more than I need. I spend about \$150 a month at the prison commissary, and I pay \$100 a month towards my restitution. All of my earthly possessions fit inside a small locker inside of my cell. I don’t have much, but I am required to give, and I do.

If I were asked to deliver a three-part sermon on this subject, I’d say that we are commanded to give obediently, wholeheartedly, and sacrificially. Giving is not an

## Let’s have some real talk about this whole Asbury revival thing

There’s a scene in Netflix’s new adaptation of *All Quiet On The Western Front* that absolutely chills me to the bone.

No, it isn’t when a man gets cooked alive by a French flamethrower. It isn’t seeing a man’s torso rotting at the top of a tree. It’s the wide-eyed, hopeful zeal of young men who are excited to head off to war with no realization of what is about to happen to most of them.

With that in mind, let me prime you on what’s happening at Asbury University in Kentucky. From blogger Samuel Sey:

The Asbury “revival” started after a 10 am chapel service last week Wednesday when a group of about 20 students and the worship team said

they felt prompted by the Holy Spirit to continue worship past the end of the chapel service.



According to one of the students I talked to, a few hours later, the president of the seminary sent an email to the students encouraging them visit the chapel to join the 20 students on what he described as an outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Apparently 200 students arrived for worship at the chapel soon after, and there has been non-stop worship ever since.

The student maintains the “revival” wasn’t planned. But it’s worth noting that Asbury University is part of what


## ‘How sweet the sound’: Classic hymn by slave-trader-turned-pastor inspires praise to God after 250 years

KANSAS CITY (BP) – Most preachers wouldn’t dare to tackle writing a sermon and a hymn for their congregation, but that was par for the course for Pastor John and his peers. On New Year’s 1773, he was preaching through 1 Chronicles 17, expositing God’s promise to David.

“Who am I, Lord God, and what is my family, that you have brought me this far?” David asks in his prayer. “And as if this were not enough in your sight, my God, you have spoken about the future of the house of your servant. You, Lord God, have

looked on me as though I were the most exalted of men. What more can David say to you for honoring your servant? For you know your servant, Lord. For the sake of your servant and according to your will, you have done this great thing and made known all these great promises.”





law. Moreover, the people must choose who will carry these tenets before a collective body, and feel confident their voices have been heard, and that the representatives they have chosen will do just that, represent them, honorably and without malice. John Kennedy, on those who serve the people, 1962: "We are all dependent on their sense of loyalty and responsibility, as well as their competence and energy".

As President Kennedy said many times, "In the final analysis", the sacredness of the ballot box, and the manner in which we choose our public servants, must not only be the most important/civic responsibility of every American citizen, but also, every person who swears an oath, or who is appointed by same.

With all this in mind, what we are seeing in our country today, would rock the worlds of those who came before us and laid the simple but intrinsic groundwork for a system of government the likes of which the world hadn't known before.

Labels like "election denier" and "insurrectionist" are now assigned to any who dare question the security and validity of things like mail in ballots, proper ID for voting and drop boxes. Jessica and some like-minded patriots are leading the charge in Rhode Island to ensure that elections are free and fair.

From her candidate web page: "A native Rhode Islander with an independent, faith-filled spirit. Jessica has worn many hats, including wife, mother, business owner, landlord, homeschooler, fisherman, gardener, forager and farmer. A concerned citizen, tired of staying on the sidelines while an extreme political class destroys the state she loves, Jessica refused to be silent".

Jessica and I shared a conversation via tele conference with Magan Brillo, another staunch defender of free and fair elections for all, and who together with Sara Vieira have been coordinating at the state and national level with organizations like RI Elections and Education <http://rifairelectionsandeducation.com>, The Election Integrity Network,

<https://whoscounting.us> and Rhody For Integrity, <https://Rhody4integrity.com>. These patriots understand the game and how it has to be played. The opposition, in the form of groups like "Let Rhode Island Vote", are engaged and networking on a number of levels, pushing every avenue and talking point, up to and including an entire re-write of the founding Documents, in order to cheat their way to victory. Actually, competing in the arena of ideas never goes well for them.

During our conversation, Jessica and Magan spoke of their efforts and meetings on Smith Hill, where they witnessed firsthand the treachery and deception that have become hallmarks of Rhode Island politics. Bills like (2022-H 7100A, 2022-S 2007A), very clearly speak to the intention of law makers in the Ocean State, and again, are a microcosm of efforts by the Leftist machine across the country. This is straight off Governor McKee's web page. Let this sink in and ask yourself, is this free and fair, or manipulative cheating to force a desired outcome?

(2022-H 7100A, 2022-S 2007A) makes mail voting easier by allowing online mail ballot applications, and permitting any voter to use a mail ballot or an emergency mail ballot without needing an excuse for why they can't visit their polling location on Election Day. It also drops the requirement that mail ballots be either signed by two witnesses or notarized. Instead, voters' signatures will be verified using their registration records using a four-tiered verification process. The bill requires every municipality to maintain at least one drop box where voters can deposit their ballots securely through the close of polls on Election Day. Additionally, the act allows nursing home residents to opt in to automatically receive applications for mail ballots for every subsequent election.

Jessica did tell me about their own efforts and those of the above organizations. She spoke of networking and coordination that she hasn't seen before, and that is reaching thousands of voters across the state and across the nation. People are beginning to understand the importance of these elections, and that if they are compromised, then our country is compromised.

Jessica and Magan talked about the push in RI for the "Ranked Choice Voting" system in use in states like Alaska and Maine, which allows voters to rank multiple candidates in order of preference, triggering a sort of instant runoff, if no candidate gets over the 50 percent mark. Sounds good, but as we read more about "RCV", as it's called, it smacks of voter manipulation, and a system whereby you keep counting until you get the desired result.

Jessica also said something that really got my attention. Mainly because I've been screaming about it for years. She told me she held countless events, spoke to thousands of voters, and knocked on no less than five thousand doors and still lost the election. I was shocked, even for a leftist state like Rhode Island. And then she explained that she talked to many Christians who told her that they simply don't vote! This has been a sticking point for me for years, as I've talked to many Christians myself, who believe their faith is all they need, and that Jesus will do the rest. Now this is all well and good, but it's also a dangerous and even selfish way of thinking. There are many passages in the Bible where government is foremost in the discussion, and many others where Jesus even tells followers to adhere to government rule, and to "render unto Caesar what is Caesars."

In any event, if Christians simply get in the game, and support Godly candidates of character, then turning this ship in the right direction

would clearly be much easier.

My conversation with Jessica and Magan was both enlightening and

maddening. Everything from how foreign workers votes are now outpacing military votes overseas, to USPS whistleblowers alleging the beleaguered agency is most certainly using its role in the mail-in ballot system. From manipulate the tally to crooked poll workers and voter addresses coming back as business addresses. And of course the ones we hear about all the time, like dead folks coming back from the grave to vote. The bottom line, the American Election System is in disarray. And if you think that our enemies don't see it and are actually helping to promote or fix it, then you're not being intellectually honest with yourself, or anyone else for that matter.

In the end we talked about many of the issues facing our country today, from parental choice and the whole "trans" issue, to abortion up to birth. Ultimately, the common denominator in fending off these assaults on the values that made this nation the greatest in human history, is electing men and woman who will carry our banner to the school committee, the mayor's office, the state legislature, and to DC and the White House. Only when we have confidence in that process, will "We the People" be on the right course.

So to Jessica and Magan, and all the other patriots who can see the danger, and who have decided to

engage in our stead and on behalf of our children, we thank you. And we also pledge our support, both in faith, prayer and deed.

In closing, I did talk ask Jessica and Magan about what is needed for this fight. And they both agreed that foremost is prayer. But they also are in need of a good lawyer to guide them through the legal weeds that grow in the political fields, often choking out the message. So, if there is a likeminded attorney out there, who can also read the writing on the wall, and is willing to join and engage, please reach out

to Jessica, Magan, Sarah, or all three. Your service is sought and appreciated.

Also, and I'm talking to my Christian brothers and sisters out there, your prayer is always welcome and needed. But you've also got to get out to that polling station and bring that faith with you, as you support candidates who have you and your family's best interest in mind and at heart. Together we can make a difference. Together we can beat back the tide of socialism and woke culture being forced down our throats every day and through every media avenue out there, polluting the minds and souls of our young ones. Together we can bring GOD back into government, as it was intended from the beginning, and save our children's America.

Please reach out by way of the links below my friends. If the events of the day are telling us anything, it's likely that our time is not infinite, and that we may not have much of it left. Wake up, and let there be a sense of urgency in your efforts...

## Why Are So Many Denominations Catering To The Depraved Philosophies Of Our Day?

What happens when a professing church becomes more concerned with pleasing men and bowing to the current cultural fads than with pleasing God and “rightly handling the word of truth”? 2 Timothy 2:15 Well, what happens is a quick slide into error, false teaching, and—eventually—apostasy. And that’s happening to so many denominations right before our eyes. Consider this headline: “Church of England explores gender neutral God.”

According to reports, “the Church of England will look into the use of gender neutral terms to refer to God in prayers” after “a priest asked about developing more inclusive language in authorized forms of worship and sought options for those who wish to speak of God in a ‘non-gendered way.’” Reportedly, a church spokesperson said:

Christians have recognized since ancient times that God is neither male nor female. . . . Yet the variety of ways of address-

ing and describing God found in scripture has not always been reflected in our worship.

Now, this spokesperson is either intentionally or ignorantly misrepresenting what Christians from “ancient times” have believed. No, God is not male or female in the human way we think of sex and gender. After all, “God is spirit” (John 4:24) and doesn’t have a body like us. But recognizing that God isn’t like us isn’t the same as saying God “is neither male nor

female” because God has chosen to reveal himself to us—and he did so in the masculine! As we write in (the Answers In Genesis) statement of faith,

The Triune God has revealed himself in Scripture in the male gender with masculine pronouns and masculine titles such as Father, Son, God, King, Priest, and Prophet (Psalm 5:2; Matthew 28:19; John 14:26).

And, no, there are not (as the Church of England spokesperson claims)

varieties of ways (in the way he means it!) of addressing and describing the biblical God that Christians haven’t used in our worship, because God did not reveal himself to mankind in a gender-neutral or feminine way. He chose to reveal himself in the masculine, culminating, of course, in the arrival of the God-man (not God-woman or God-nonbinary person!). And this isn’t some trifling point! Adam, the first man, is the head of the human race, and in him we all sinned and now die. Jesus came as the “last Adam,” who, through his death, brings life to all

option for those who follow Christ. We are compelled to give. It is our obligation. It is our duty.

To give obediently, we begin with our tithe. We are all familiar with the charge of Malachi 3:10, “Bring all of the tithes into the storehouse!” In Malachi’s first chapter we are also admonished to give God our best, the first of our fruits, not the dregs, remnants, rejects, and defects. For God is owed His Share. In Matthew 21:33-29, Christ’s parable of the tenants demonstrates God’s relationship with us. It reminds us that He owns it all, and we are simply using His property with His (revocable) permission. This same parable as relayed in Luke 20:9-14 reveals the ultimate conflict at issue as those who possessed God’s property mistakenly came to the belief that they could take it for themselves, saying “then everything will be ours!”

But we don’t own anything. Our very life, our bodies, our health, our ability to earn income, our possessions—all of these things come from God and are owned by God.

Start with that when you ask the Lord how He wants you to give. For it already belongs to Him, all of it. What does He want you to do with that which is His?

When we are giving obediently, we are giving to the church, He requires that we give to those who are good stewards. Luke 12:42-46. A portion of what we give is designed to pay our leaders for their work as we advance the Kingdom of God together. 1 Corinthians 9:3-14. Some of it is to care for the poor, orphans, and widows. James 1:27; Galatians 2:10. We are to give in a manner consistent with the Lord’s desires. 2 Corinthians 8:5. We are to be honest with ourselves, with God, and with the church about our giving. Malachi 1:14; Acts 5:1-11.

To give wholeheartedly, we must give gladly with joy. He wants us to give generously. 2 Corinthians 8:1-15. God wants us to give cheerfully. He wants us to give willingly. 2 Corinthians 9:7. He reminds us that when we are giving to the church to provide for the needs of others that we are giving to Him, meeting His needs as if He were the one needing shelter, clothing, food, or water. Matthew 25:31-46.

When we are giving wholeheartedly, we are giving as an act of worship. The woman who poured expensive perfume on Jesus was demonstrating her devotion to Him, declaring His value to her, and expressing her subservience to her Master in the extravagance of her act. Luke 7:37-38.

We are giving wholeheartedly when

we are exercising our faith, demonstrating our complete and utter trust in the Lord as we show Him and others that we depend solely on Him as our Source; that no matter how much we give to Him, He will always provide more. Ecclesiastes 11:1; Luke 6:38.

To give sacrificially, we emulate the widow who gave her last penny.

The widow’s mite of Luke 21:1-4 forces us to see that no matter how little we may possess, we are to give it to Him. Jesus remarked of her, “She put in everything. She has nothing left to live on.” Is this our own practice in giving?

When reading the story of Christ’s interaction with the rich young ruler in Luke 18:18-30, we too often focus on the struggles of the wealthy without asking whether or not we are held to the same challenge. Has God asked of us the same? That we sell everything that we have and give it to the poor in order to follow Christ?

But this is exactly what Jesus asked of His disciples as well. In Mark 8:34-36, He told them to take up their cross and follow Him, to lose their life here on earth if they

want to save it. In Luke 14:27, He admonished them that “whoever doesn’t” give up everything to follow Him “cannot be my disciple.” Is this something that we have taken seriously? Have we actually given up everything to follow Him? I know believers who have.

When we are giving sacrificially, we are becoming totally dependent upon Him.



In Luke 9:57-58, Jesus reminds us that He had no home: “Foxes have holes, but the Son of Man has no

place to lay his head.” In Acts chapters 2 and 4 we are given a glimpse of the early church taking this to heart in that they “shared everything.”

Christ gave us an example of how to live. He is our example of how to give. He gave up everything for us. In Philippians 2:5-11, we are reminded just how much Jesus gave up in order to take upon the form of man for 33 years, divesting Himself of His authority and power for a time, living with us, suffering torture and death in a way that most of us will never experience, not even close.

We shouldn’t worry about our

needs, for He supplies all of our needs. Luke 12:22-34. In Matthew 6:19-34, He tells us not to “store up treasures for yourselves on earth,” not to serve Money, and to “seek first His Kingdom and His righteousness.” Malachi 3 comes with this startling challenge: “Test me in this!”

While writing this the Lord provided me an opportunity to give to another a small portion of what He has given me. I did, quickly and obediently, but I was not cheerful about it. In fact, I complained to the Lord about the oblivious selfishness of the recipient of my giving. As the Holy Spirit chastised me for my attitude, helping me realize that I had failed to do the very thing that I was in the middle of writing about, I laughed--then repented. I have a lot of work to do in this area. For even though I don’t have much, everything that I have is His. How dare I resent giving a small portion of it away to someone that I considered undeserving. I was tested and failed.

Perhaps next time I will not fail. I think most of us have failed to give in the manner in which we should. Perhaps from this point forward we will not fail to give Him what He is owed.

Others had grown up in churches that never catechized them in the faith. These kids loved being part of the 4-hour worship sets and the 2-hour intensive prayer meetings. It was experimental and emotional: Exactly what a vanilla Midwest kid needed to feel like he or she was coming closer to the God of the universe. These kids were reaching out for authenticity and a sense of deeper purpose. Untethered from tradition or history, they began to develop their own traditions or copy things that seemed to “enhance” worship. People would bring shofars and cymbals to gatherings. People would “dance in the Spirit.” People would come over to me and start babbling randomly in an attempt to whip themselves into a spiritual fervor and prove they had the gift of tongues.

When I came across all of this, I identified it as the growing pains of young believers. These kids didn’t have a church framework to fit into. They were a bunch of 18-22-year-olds just figuring out how the world works. They had


is known as the revivalist movement — a group of Charismatic Christians who consistently attempt to produce revivals.

People from all over the nation have been flocking to this ongoing worship service at the college’s chapel — and it’s inspired a lot of feedback. There’s two large groups of people arguing on social media about this whole thing right now. One is the milquetoast, kill-’em-with-kindness crowd. The other is the battle-hardened Christian who has been in the trenches the last decade or so.

You know, the type of person who has tried to warn the skinny-jean-wearing megachurch pastors (who talk about broksi Jesus) about the doctors castrating kids, the teachers grooming kindergartners in the finer details of gay sex, the churches trotting out corrupt NIH directors to Christianize government propaganda, and the president sending the FBI after pro-life dads.

I joined InterVarsity Christian

Fellowship and quickly saw the campus ministry quadruple in size in just a year or two. This happened with other ministries such as Cru — and not just on my Michigan campus, but around the nation. Christian college conferences were packed to the gills with people who were sold out for Jesus.

I grew up in the church and had a father who disciplined me in everything from the Psalms to the finer points of systematic theology presented in Paul’s letter to the Romans. I grew up in a variety of churches — Lutheran, old-school Baptist, new-school Baptist, Reformed, and Covenant congregations. When I entered college, it was with a decade or more of knowledge of the faith, the history of the Church, and immersion in the Christian subculture of the ‘90s and ‘00s that so many of us still remember today. But not everyone had that.

Many of my friends in college became Christians after plugging into ministries on campus.

who will believe. Since death came into the world by a man, the atonement for death needed to be paid by a man (see 1 Corinthians 15).

Now, the priest asking the church to consider “gender neutral” liturgy is seeking such language for those “who wish to speak of God in a ‘non-gendered way.’” But wait - isn’t our culture supposedly all about using each person’s preferred terms, pronouns, and titles? Isn’t ignoring their preferred pronouns and instead using the ones we prefer “transphobic” and “hateful”? But these people want to do the very same thing to God by ignoring how he has revealed himself and calling him whatever they want!



This just shows that those requesting this new liturgy don’t really believe God is who he says he is. I would go so far as to say that many leaders in this denomination don’t care how God has chosen to reveal himself because they probably don’t truly believe he even exists. They don’t really care about God at all.

What they really care about is their own opinions about the world and therefore about God. And those in leadership care about catering to the depraved philosophies of our day so they can appear “inclusive” and “loving” (by our world’s definitions) - it’s fear of men, rather than fear of God! And it does no one any good!

Those coming to these “gender neutral” church services are not going

to hear the biblical gospel - the most important message, which saves people for eternity! - explained. Think about it: if a leader or congregation is too afraid to use the pronouns and titles God has chosen for himself because some might be offended, they certainly aren’t going to preach the message that everyone is a sinner and that they cannot do anything to save themselves! That’s the most offensive message of all!

This question of who gets to decide which pronouns we use for God (and for people, made male or female in his image) comes down to a question of authority: is God or is man the ultimate authority? If we start with God’s Word, then God is the authority and we refer to him in the way he has chosen to reveal himself to us. If we’re the authority, then God’s Word doesn’t matter, and we can do whatever we want!

turned-pastor named John Newton became the lyrics to one of the most sung hymns - or songs of any sort - ever. “Amazing grace, how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me.” The seeds for each verse are in 1 Chronicles 17 for those who read closely.

**‘How sweet the sound’**

2023 marks the 250th anniversary of the hymn, a song synonymous with Christian victory in the face of dangers, toils and snares, as well as man’s overwhelming sin.

“‘Amazing Grace’ is a timeless hymn,” said Matt Swain, the assistant dean of Worship Ministries at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary (MBTS). “It spans the ages and it had spoken to generations and people from all different walks of life. Even people who are not Christians or religious at all know the tune and the text to ‘Amazing Grace.’ What’s interesting is that even though everybody just seems to know it, they don’t necessarily quite understand what it is that the hymn is really about, which is somewhat ironic.”

**‘I once was lost’**

There can be no doubt that Newton knew of what he preached and wrote. In his youth, he famously took to the sea and was heavily involved in the slave trade. He neglected his faith and mocked God and those who believed. As if that wasn’t bad enough, he had a bad reputation... among slave traders. He was a foul-mouthed, insubordinate wretch, even to the point of being imprisoned while at sea, chained alongside the slaves he was transporting. It would take amazing grace, indeed, to save him.

In March 1748, while his ship was tossed by a violent storm in the North Atlantic, a crew member

who was standing where Newton had been moments before was swept overboard. He and his crewmates labored for hours to pump water from the ship, and expecting to be capsized at any moment.

The ship did not sink, and two weeks later when it limped into the harbor, Newton began to ponder the mercy he’d been shown. Was he worthy of God’s mercy? Was he redeemable?

**‘But now I’m found’**

His conversion was not immediate then and there, but the seed of the gospel was taking root and making his need for forgiveness impossible to ignore. “I was greatly deficient in many respects,” he wrote. “I cannot consider myself to have been a believer in the full sense of the word, until a considerable time afterwards.”

He continued sailing in the slave trade between Africa and the New World, but he also got married and soon found himself physically unable and unwilling to meet the demands of life on the open seas. Returning to the teachings of childhood, he began to teach himself Latin, Greek and theology. He and his wife, Mary, threw themselves in the church community, and by 1764 he was offered a pastoral role in Olney, a village of about 2,500 people about 50 miles north of London.

It was there he began preaching and presenting poems and songs to reinforce the message of his sermons. A few years later, “Amazing Grace” was born.

“This song really came out of a life of hopelessness, Matt Swain said.


“As a sinner - as a wretch - he was radically saved and started a life of ministry and servitude unto the Lord by grace.

“This is just conjecture on my part,” Matt said, “but I don’t know how he could not have been impacted when he looked back on his life, much like David, by seeing the miraculous things that God has done. In some ways it’s testimonial, but I don’t know that it was overtly meant to be testimonial so much as it’s just how grace works in the life of the believer. But you can’t just read through the hymn and know his story and not think, ‘Wow, he had to have had that on his mind.’”

**‘Grace will lead me Home’**

But Newton was more than just a redeemed hymn writer with a dark past. A few years after “Amazing Grace,” in 1779, he moved to London where he continued preaching. He was one of only two evangelical Anglican priests in the capital, and he grew in popularity, even among the Methodists and Baptists of the time.

It was during this time he connected with William Wilberforce, a young member of Parliament who was struggling with staying in office while seeing evil in the world such as slavery. When he sought Newton’s advice, he advised him to “serve God where he was.” Wilberforce followed his advice, and his political views were informed by his faith and by his desire to promote Christianity and Christian ethics in private and public. That included a vocal and active fight for the abolition of slavery, one that Newton joined.

Ultimately, regardless of whether we allow the Bible to be the authority in our lives or not, God is the authority. And he will have the final say in judgment on those who twist his Word and lead others astray into sin and false teaching. Now, if that is you, repent today, trust Jesus Christ for salvation, and obey his Word.  
2 Corinthians 11:13-15 KJV -

“For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.”

“In many ways, John Newton was kind of like the Billy Graham of his day,” said Angela Swain, associate professor of music at MBTS. “If you think of how Billy Graham was to many of our presidents, that’s how John Newton was to William Wilberforce.”

Three decades after he had retired from the slave trade, Newton published a pamphlet called, “Thoughts Upon the Slave Trade,” describing the horrific conditions of the slave ships during his service as crew. The confession and apology, he wrote, “will always be a subject of humiliating reflection to me, that I was once an active instrument in a business at which my heart now shudders.”

Thanks in part to both men, the Slave Trade Act of 1807 brought British involvement in slavery to an end.

While the end of slavery in the New World was still decades away, “Amazing Grace” and its gospel message were taking hold in Britain.

**‘No less days to sing God’s praise’**

As profound and simple as it is, Newton’s song didn’t exactly catch on at home, and Newton was ready the next week to write a new song.

“It only became popular later in the United States,” Angela said. “Irony of ironies.”

It caught on in the U.S. in part due to its musicality and folk-melody, but largely, the Swains believe, due to its message during the Second Great Awakening.

“Theology leads to our doxology,” Angela said.

“It’s so plainly a song about the gospel,” Matt continued. “Whether we were saved from something like the slave trade, or if our conversion was less notable than John Newton’s, it still speaks of the power of God unto salvation. For those that experience that grace, we are being brought from death to life, and that in and of itself is a radical thing.”

That popularity lives on, even two and half centuries later.

“Lots of people embrace the hymn,” Matt said. “I mean, Elvis Presley sang it.”

But beyond the music and at its foundation, “Amazing Grace” is still about the gospel, and that’s potentially what has made the hymn stick around in the cultural consciousness.

“Strong hymns have strong theology,” Matt said. “It’s the grace we’ve been given that gives it that power for those of us who have been saved through the blood of Christ. It’s an even more powerful testimony to know the life of John Newton, to see what the gospel can do in his life of sin.”

## She Was Punished for Refusing to Kneel, Won \$100K in Court

A former standout Virginia Tech women's soccer player who alleged the team's head coach persecuted and targeted her for refusing to kneel in support of Black Lives Matter (BLM) in the fall 2020 season will receive a \$100,000 settlement as part of an agreement to dismiss the federal lawsuit she filed against the coach.

Kiersten Hening filed a federal lawsuit against Virginia Tech head women's soccer coach Charles "Chugger" Adair, claiming he removed her as a starter on the team and reduced her playing time in an attempt to force her to quit the team due to her criticisms of the BLM movement. Hening was a junior during the 2020 season and had been one of the team's top defenders her previous two seasons as a freshman and sophomore where she started the vast majority of games.

The suit argued that Hening was a "talented defender" who had the most minutes played on the entire team as the 2020 season started. She was even selected to represent the team to media outlets before the season began.

On Sept. 1, 2020, shortly before

the start of the season and in the immediate aftermath of the BLM uprising that began with the death of George Floyd earlier that year, an advisory committee of student athlete representatives discussed ways of supporting the BLM movement, including by wearing BLM-themed face masks, wrist and armbands, and warmup attire.

In the lawsuit, Hening alleges that most of the women's soccer team players supported the initiative, including head coach Adair. Adair

also suggested replacing "Hokies," the name of Virginia Tech athletic teams, emblazoned on the back of the soccer team's uniforms with the names of alleged victims of police

misconduct and wanted players to kneel before games in a display of solidarity with the BLM movement.

Hening did not support these initiatives, expressing her reservations with other players on the team through text messages, which ultimately came to the attention of Adair. On Sept. 3, two days after the advisory committee's recommendations, Hening's teammates insisted coach Adair address "the fact that some of his players were 'racist' and did not support BLM," according to the lawsuit.

Hening refused to kneel with the rest of the team's starters during the opening match of the season on Sept. 12, 2020, resulting in her being the subject of a tirade launched against her by Adair. That began a "campaign of abuse" by the head coach, coupled with reduced playing time, that ultimately resulted in Hening's decision to leave the program on Sept. 20, 2020.

Hening insisted in the lawsuit that she supports social justice, but "does not support BLM the organization," disagreeing with the "tactics and core tenets of its mission statement, including defunding the police."

## Secret Service Threatens Minister with Arrest for Peacefully Demonstrating on a Public Sidewalk

WASHINGTON - Rev. Patrick Mahoney, Director of the Christian Defense Coalition, was recently told by the Secret Service the sidewalk was not public because Chinese officials said it "was Chinese property."

The Secret Service went on to say Mahoney would be arrested and charged with unlawful assembly because he would be demonstrating on "Chinese property." It was shocking and stunning to see America's Secret Service being bullied by the Chinese government to shut down free speech in the public square.

Rev. Mahoney informed Secret Service the sidewalk was public and not "Chinese property" and he began to peacefully demonstrate in spite of the threat of arrest and

## China Demands US “Explain Itself to the World” Over Nord Stream Attack Story

Beijing unsatisfied with dismissal of Seymour Hersh bombshell.

China has demanded that the United States “explain itself to the world” if the revelations in Seymour Hersh’s story about US intel being responsible for destroying the Nord Stream gas pipelines are true.

The Pulitzer Prize-winning investigative journalist published an article recently in which he asserted that the pipelines were destroyed by the US as part of a covert operation.

According to Hersh’s sources, the explosives were planted in June 2022 by US Navy divers under the guise of the BALTOPS 22 NATO exercise and were detonated three months later with a remote signal sent by a sonar buoy.

One source told Hersh that the plotters knew the covert operation was an “act of war,” with some in the CIA and State Department warning, “Don’t do this. It’s stupid and will be a political nightmare if it comes out.” Now Beijing is demanding that the White House

address the issue, seemingly unimpressed with the Biden administration’s rather weak response to merely label the story “false”.

In mid-February, Chinese Foreign Ministry spokeswoman Mao Ning asserted that Washington would have to bear responsibility if the report is confirmed as accurate. “If the conclusions of the investigation are true, then the US behavior is unacceptable,” the diplomat told reporters, adding that the US would



need to “explain itself to the world community.”

The Kremlin also responded to the report by demanding a fresh international investigation into the attack, which was preceded by both Joe Biden and Victoria Nuland asserting that the pipelines would be taken out if

Russia invaded Ukraine.

Kremlin Press Secretary Dmitry Peskov said Hersh’s article showed “the need for an open international investigation into this unprecedented attack on this critical infrastructure.”

“It’s a very important piece, which... must provoke the acceleration of the international probe. But we, on the contrary, witness attempts to silently wind down such international investigation,” he added.

Meanwhile, in Germany, the Alternative for Germany (AfD) party is also calling for a full inquiry. “The Pulitzer Prize winner’s suspicions must be investigated,” wrote co-chairman of the AfD parliamentary group, Tino Chrupalla.

“Has NATO’s leading power carried out an attack on our country’s vital critical infrastructure in European waters? Then one would have to question whether the alliance guarantees security in Europe or rather endangers it. The consequence would be the withdrawal of all U.S. troops.”

## Almost 900 million foreigners want to relocate

A recent Gallup poll demonstrates the folly of open borders or allowing people to immigrate into the US illegally, virtually unrestricted.

It shows that 900 million people would relocate from their countries if they could. The number one country they choose is the US, with around 160 million adults picking America. Those adults, if permitted, would come with children and other family members.

The current US population is roughly 331 million. That includes millions of illegal immigrants and other illegal border crossers who have already been allowed to enter in recent years. A record number are coming in through the US southern border virtually undeterred under the Biden administration.

The following is an excerpt from Gallup News:

The Covid-19 pandemic severely disrupted people’s mobility worldwide, but it didn’t stop them from wanting to move.

In fact, Gallup surveys show that in the second year of the pandemic, people’s desire to migrate reached its highest point in a decade.

In 2021, 16% of adults worldwide -- which projects to almost 900 million people -- said they would like to leave their own country permanently, if they could.

Gallup’s latest update on adults’ desire to move to another country is its first global estimate available since 2018. The 2021 figures are based on interviews with nearly 127,000 adults in 122 countries.

The list of countries where potential migrants say they would like to move -- if they could -- has generally been the same since Gallup started tracking these data in 2007, with the U.S. topping the list of the most desired destinations every year. This was true in 2021 as well. Just under one in five potential migrants (18%) -- or about 160 million adults worldwide -- named the U.S. as their desired future residence.

### Abrahamic Family House Opens - One Word Religion?

On Thursday, Feb. 16, the United Arab Emirates officially opened the Abrahamic Family House, consisting of a mosque, church and synagogue that face one another on the same square in Abu Dhabi.

Beside each one stands a tall pillar illuminating an Islamic crescent, Christian cross and a Jewish menorah, respectively, shining a hopeful light for interfaith tolerance and understanding.

The road to Thursday’s opening began with Pope Francis’ February 2019 trip to the UAE, where he met with the grand imam of al-Azhar, Ahmed el-Tayeb, leader of the oldest Islamic educational institute in the world. Their meeting ended with their signing of the Document on Human Fraternity, which set ambitious goals to foster interfaith understanding.

Four years later, Muslims, Christians and Jews gathered to inaugurate the three worship centers, each representing one of the three Abrahamic faiths, and a representative from each faith provided inaugural remarks.

The president of the center, Mohamed Khalifa Al Mubarak, spoke of a “new landmark” in the country, built within sight of the six-year-old Louvre Abu Dhabi. The three worship sites, he said, stand for hope “for peaceful coexistence and understanding.”

The president of the Pontifical Council for Interreligious Dialogue, Cardinal Miguel Ángel Ayuso Guixot, noting that “fear is the outcome of a lack of knowledge,” referred to the center as a “beacon of mutual understanding.” The cardinal said that believers do not need to walk away from their deeply held beliefs to befriend others and to visit their houses of worship. “Without renouncing different spiritual resources,” he said, “each has a command to live with brothers and sisters whatever their religion.”

Lastly, the chief rabbi of the

However, this figure is down from where it was in all years leading up to 2017, which suggests that policy changes and anti-immigrant rhetoric during the Trump administration likely had a lasting chilling effect on potential migrants’ desire to come to the country.

As potential migrants cooled toward the U.S., and actual migration levels to the country slumped, they warmed to its neighbor to the north. In 2021, Canada achieved its highest level of immigration in its history. And Gallup survey figures show that 8% of potential migrants -- or about 74 million people worldwide -- would like

United Kingdom, Ephraim Mirvis, referred to the moment as “historic,” seeing the “children of Abraham gathered... to build a new world.” He challenged the audience to “recognize the part of the divine in every person” so we can “shape a new world built from loving kindness.”



But while the center is novel, the UAE has been promoting tolerance for several years. The Abrahamic Family House joins other initiatives, including a special ministry of tolerance, and hosts the Abu Dhabi Forum for Peace. The UAE has also demonstrated a commitment to promoting tolerance outside its borders, supporting UNESCO’s effort to reconstruct a historic mosque and two nearby churches in Iraq’s second-largest city, Mosul, after they were destroyed by ISIS.

Some have questioned the sincerity of these types of efforts, seeing them as a way to distract from the region’s rough politics or deficits when it comes to democracy. But such work can simultaneously reflect a country’s interests and values. The UAE’s leadership has also focused on countering ISIS’ ideology and the Muslim Brotherhood, and the Abrahamic Family House can be seen as a positive flipside to these darker battles.

Soon a new Hindu temple will open in Abu Dhabi, further diversifying the religious landscape. But with the proliferation of good things, observers have questioned how far the tolerance initiative will expand. Will the welcoming spirit include converts from Islam, nonbelievers and other communities persecuted in nearby countries, such as Bahá’ís and Ahmadis? Do the overlapping initiatives reinforce each other, or duplicate or dilute the overall impact? With all the world’s challenges, can the new complex foster an environment respectful of different beliefs or is it the beginning of the end times One World Religion revealed in scripture?

Gallup’s data suggest the Covid-19 pandemic did not dampen people’s desire to move -- which is likely an important factor in why migration has been able to rebound so quickly in many places, including in countries such as the U.S.

From 2021 to 2022, net international migration exceeded 1 million residents, suggesting that migration patterns may be returning to their pre-pandemic norms.

## Church of England wants to change God’s pronouns to be gender-neutral

The Church of England announced a new project this week to use gender-neutral terms when referring to God in church services. This announcement has roused strong feelings on both sides of the aisle, as conservatives defend the titles by which God is named in the Bible and liberals rally around the more “inclusive language.”

The issue was raised at the church’s legislative body, the General Synod, where Joanna Stobart asked bishops “to provide more options for those who wish to use authorized liturgy and speak of God in a non-gendered way, particularly in authorized absolutions where many of the prayers offered for use refer to God using male pronouns.”

We have been exploring the use of gendered language in relation to God for several years, in collaboration with the Faith and Order Commission. After some dialogue between the two commissions in this area, a new joint project on gendered language will begin this spring. - Michael Iprgrave, vice chairman of the Liturgical Commission

In practice, this change would mean priests no longer using “He” or “Him” in prayers or in service. It would even extend to dropping God’s title as “Father” and removing it from the so-called “Lord’s Prayer.”

## Rite Aid Is the Latest Pharmacy to Hand Out Abortion Pills

## Former WH doctor for Trump, Obama blasts ‘alarming’ Biden health report: ‘The cover-up needs to end’

Texas GOP Rep. Ronny Jackson, a former White House physician, is calling for an end to the “cover-up” of President Biden’s health after the president’s physical earlier this week claimed that he is healthy and fit to serve as commander in chief.

“The majority of Americans can see that Biden’s mental health is in total decline, yet there is no transparency from the White House on what’s going on, if anything, to address this issue and his inability to do his job,” Jackson told Fox News Digital. “Yesterday’s written physical exam report released by Biden’s physician, Kevin O’Connor, further confirms that this administration is still adamant about concealing the truth.”

Jackson also took issue with the fact that the report from Biden’s physical, the second one he’s taken since entering office, made no mention of the president undergoing a cognitive test amid his “deteriorating mental health.”

“Nowhere in the report was there mention of Biden’s deteriorating mental health,” Jackson said. “This is alarming, considering I have already sent three letters to the White House demanding that Biden receive a cognitive test and that the results be made public, all of which have been ignored. Everyone can see something is wrong — the cover-up needs to end.”

Jackson, who previously served as the White House physician to

former Presidents Barack Obama and Donald Trump, faced criticism from Obama for his critique of Biden’s cognitive health on the 2020 campaign trail.

In his 2022 memoir, Jackson detailed a stern and “scathing” email he received from Obama about comments he had made on Twitter about then-presidential candidate Biden’s mental state. “I have made a point of not commenting on your service in my successor’s administration and have always spoken highly of you both in public and in private. You always served me and my family well, and I have considered you not only a fine doctor and service member but also a friend,” Obama wrote in the email to Jackson.

“That’s why I have to express my disappointment at the cheap shot you took at Joe Biden via Twitter. It was unprofessional and beneath the office that you once held. It was also disrespectful to me and the many friends you had in our administration. You were the personal physician to the President of the United States as well as an admiral in the U.S. Navy. I expect better, and I hope upon reflection that you will expect more of yourself in the future,” Obama added in his message to Jackson.

In a memo released Thursday, White House physician Kevin O’Connor, a retired Army colonel who has served in the role since January 2021, wrote: “President Biden remains a healthy, vigorous 80-year-old male who is fit to successfully

execute the duties of the presidency.”

One lesion was discovered on Biden’s chest and removed, according to the report, and the president still experiences a stiff gait, but it hasn’t worsened since last year. Biden continues to experience symptoms of gastroesophageal reflux, primarily having to clear his throat more often, mostly after meals, the report said. O’Connor said the reflux is the source of Biden’s throat clearing and coughing.

O’Connor noted that the main medical event for Biden in the past year was his upper respiratory infection from COVID-19 last summer. He said that Biden’s oxygen levels never fell below 97%.

The results come as the president faces questions about his age amid speculation that he will seek reelection in 2024, though he has not yet announced his official decision.

Republican presidential candidate Nikki Haley took aim at the president, as well as his predecessor, former President Trump, on Wednesday, saying that politicians over the age of 75 should have to take a mental cognitive test before assuming office.

In 2021, Biden was evaluated by O’Connor, who wrote at the time that the president “remains a healthy, vigorous, 78-year-old male, who is fit to successfully execute the duties of the Presidency.”

## CDC Adds Original COVID mRNA Vaccine to Childhood Schedule Despite Known Harms

(The Defender) - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on Thursday added COVID-19 vaccination to its routine immunization schedule for children and adults.

Although the CDC does not have the authority to set requirements itself, the agency’s immunization schedule provides formal guidance for state and local public health officials who set the rules for which vaccines are required to attend school. The schedule also is the basis for vaccine recommendations made by most physicians.

“Given all that we have learned about the dangers and ineffectiveness of COVID-19 shots over the last two years, it is horrifying to see the CDC now recommend this as a routine shot to children,” Mary Holland, Children’s Health Defense (CHD) president and general counsel told The Defender. “Although it is unsurprising given the agency capture, it is nonetheless tragic,” she added.

Thursday’s move formalized the recommendation by the agency’s vaccine advisory committee, which on Oct. 20, 2022, voted unanimously (15-0) to recommend adding COVID-19 vaccines for children as young as 6 months old to the new Child and Adolescent Immunization Schedule.

Under the new guidelines, the CDC recommends healthy children 6 months to 11 years old receive a pri-



mary series of two doses of the mRNA Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech monovalent COVID-19 vaccine, followed by a booster of the bivalent shot.

It recommends that healthy people age 12 and older receive two doses of either the Moderna, Pfizer or Novavax vaccine followed by a bivalent booster.

All COVID-19 vaccines being administered in the U.S. to people under 18 are Emergency Use Authorized (EUA) products. The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) did grant full approval to Pfizer’s Comirnaty COVID-19 vaccine for ages 12 and older, however, the Comirnaty vaccine is not available in the U.S. — which means all children who get the Pfizer vaccine are getting an EUA product.

In the congressional hearing on the Biden administration’s response to COVID-19, Rep. Dan Crenshaw

(R-Texas) asked CDC Director Dr. Rochelle Walensky, why the CDC broke with its own norms and put an EUA vaccine on the childhood immunization schedule for a disease that poses very little risk to children and for which the vaccine poses many potential side effects without preventing transmission.

Walensky responded: “The reason that the ACIP [Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices] recommended the CDC put the COVID-19 vaccine on the pediatric schedule was only because it was the only way it could be covered in our ‘Vaccines for Children’ program. ... It was the only way that our underinsured children would be able to have access to the vaccines ... That was the reason to put it there.”


Data collected by the CDC through its Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) and a growing number of other sources indicate serious health risks associated with COVID-19 vaccination for children.

“The COVID vaccines have not been shown to be either effective or safe for children,” CHD argued in an amicus brief filed in Louisiana last year. “The benefits to children are minuscule, while the risks — including the risk of potentially fatal heart damage — are ‘known’ and ‘serious,’ as the FDA itself has acknowledged.”

The CFR's main enemy is the people of the world, particularly the American people. This explains why, behind every single act of treason against the American



## Eagles QB Jalen Hurts sets Super Bowl records in loss, aims to 'be what God called me to be'

Moments after the Kansas City Chiefs defeated the Philadelphia Eagles, 38-35, on Sunday night

in Super Bowl LVII, Eagles quarterback Jalen Hurts was already thinking about the future.

"You either win or you learn, that's how I feel," Hurts said in his postgame press conference. "Win, lose, I always reflect on the things I could have done better — anything you could have done better to try and take that next step." He expanded later, "It is a tough feeling to come up short. It's a very tough feeling, but I know the direction is to rise, and that will be the M.O. going forward."

Aside from a second-quarter fumble that was returned for a touchdown, Hurts played one of the best games of his life on the biggest stage. He threw for 304 yards and a touchdown on 27-of-38 passing, and ran for 70 yards and three touchdowns on 15 carries, setting records for the most rushing yards and rushing touchdowns ever by a quarterback

in the Super Bowl. His three rushing TDs tied the most in a Super Bowl by any player, regardless of position.

"To me, [Hurts] played the best game I've seen him play in the two years that we've been together. He was outstanding," Eagles second-year head coach Nick Sirianni said in his postgame press conference. "I really thought he was in complete control. He did things with his legs in the run game. He did things with his arm in the pass game, made some unbelievable throws, unbelievable reads. I

thought he played outstanding. ... I'm sure glad he's our quarterback."

Hurts' maturation as a quarterback is a big reason why the Eagles won 14 regular-season games this year and earned the NFC's No. 1 seed in the playoffs. He tossed 22 touchdowns with only six interceptions, while rushing for 760 yards and 13 touchdowns in 15 regular-season games. The Eagles were 16-2 (including the playoffs) this year with Hurts as the starting QB.

His threat as a runner and a passer led a Philly offense that trailed only the Super Bowl-champion Chiefs in scoring offense this season, a far cry from where the Eagles were only two short years ago when they finished 26th. Hurts was a rookie and only played sparingly then.

Amid his rapid rise to NFL superstardom, the third-year pro has remained vocal about his faith in

God. During a press conference in the days leading up to the big game, Hurts was asked about his faith. "I really lean on Him and I try to keep Him in the center of everything that I do, because I know without God, I wouldn't be where I am today," Hurts responded. "I wouldn't be the man I am today without having that faith in Him, without integrity and leadership

A federal judge rebuked the organization for its “tactics... to get the attention of the public.” This pattern of “tactics” also seems to be at play with its request to fly a satanic flag after the Supreme Court ruled in a historic victory that it was unconstitutional for Boston to deny the flying of a Christian flag. The satanic flag has not been flown as the flag-raising program in Boston has been suspended.

While TST seems to be distinct from the Church of Satan as one that does not “worship Satan” nor believe in his existence, that doesn’t seem to stop those embracing the name of the Lawless One from being particularly concerned with the law, especially where it intersects with faith.

The Satanic Temple has filed several lawsuits against various cities and states to try to force them to recognize satanic practices or at least to reject Christian ones. For example, TST sued the state of Arkansas for refusing to allow it to put up a large statue of Satan at the state capitol. TST

argued that because Arkansas had erected a monument of the Ten Commandments, they could not discriminate by rejecting a satanic monument. In another case, TST sued Texas and Missouri for their laws restricting abortion, arguing that satanists in those states have a “religious right” to practice “abortion rituals.” In a letter to the FDA, TST’s lawyer even stated that TST’s “Satanic Abortion Ritual is a sacrament.” As mentioned earlier, closer to home, TST sued the city of Boston for refusing to invite a satanist leader to offer the opening prayer at a Boston City Council meeting. TST has yet to win any of its cases.

The Satanic Temple’s cases, like many of its other schemes, seem to be less about advancing satanism than they are about inhibiting Christianity in the public square. TST might be more accurately described as an anti-Christian

trolling group than as a pro-Satan activist group. But like the Freedom From Religion Foundation and other organizations, TST is hell-bent on eliminating any reference to Christ in public spaces and removing Christian morality from American law. Therefore, whether or not its members truly worship Beelzebub, it’s not a stretch to say that they are doing the devil’s work.

The event has drawn national concern from Christians. Local pastors have responded with the announcement of a revival campaign of worship and prayer over the same weekend, gathering Christians from Boston and beyond to unite against SatanCon.

## Spirit-Filled Christian Detained in Psych Ward for Testimony

The freedom to worship and testify about one's faith and the workings of God in their life is central to the founding and uniqueness of America.

So, when an award-winning principal, who shares publicly how the Holy Spirit has filled her heart and she received the gifting of tongues, is summarily detained by law enforcement against her will, it shows something has shifted in the spiritual atmosphere of America.

Mary Fulp is the principal of Colony High School in Palmer, Alaska, and the 2022 Alaska Principal of the Year.

Yet, it was not until she shared a Facebook Live video of her radical encounter with God that filled her with the Holy Spirit and she started speaking in tongues, that she was viewed as mentally ill. Her family became concerned with her mental state and confronted her about this revelation that she shared publicly.

After, Fulp said, the conversations became unproductive, she asked her family to leave. They refused and called a state trooper to the house who reported Fulp was of "sound mind and body when she met with me."

"She asked me if I wanted them trespassed and I said, 'If they don't leave, then we can have that conversation, but please ask them to leave,'" Fulp wrote on Facebook. As reported by the Alaska Watchman, "After the children left, Fulp later received a visit from two other troopers who said they had a court order to take her to

them trespassed, and I said, 'Only if they don't leave.' So, they left and came back, and this is what I get.

"I'm getting taken to the hospital for claiming that Jesus is King and claiming that I stand with the Martin Luther King civil rights movement ... So, I would like to see this show up in the news,"

Fulp continued. Fulp's video ends when they arrived at the hospital, with the officer instructing her to stop recording due to the sensitive information held within the hospital.

"I mean, I'm claiming all of the biblical principles, and this is where I go – to the hospital because they think I'm crazy, because the world is such a mess that it takes someone bold to say, 'You got to put things back in their proper order,'" Fulp said. "And so here I am getting a psych eval because I love Jesus."

Except she was subject to more than just an unlawfully given psych test. According to a statement released by the Anchorage-based Thompson Law Group who is representing Fulp, her treatment at the hands of hospital staff was representative of a horror film. "She was strapped to a gurney, held down by several staff and

Mat-Su Regional Medical Center for a mandatory psychological evaluation."

Fulp recorded the entire situation on her phone and streamed it onto Facebook Live. "It's called an ex parte order, which means they got the order without your input," one of the officers explained to Fulp. "So, they got the order without my input, because I just set some very clear boundaries that I wanted them to back off," Fulp explained to the officers. "They didn't honor those boundaries. A trooper came by earlier and asked me if I wanted

forcibly injected with psychotropic medication without her consent and without a court order authorizing the administration of such medications.

"She spent days in a cold, dark mental health hospital room, during which time staff breached her federally protected HIPAA rights by disclosing their 'opinions' as to her circumstances to individuals who did not possess any authorization to receive her federally protected HIPAA private mental health information. This traumatic experience is a free citizen's worst nightmare, and this broken system has caused her, and her children, inexcusable and immeasurable harm."

All because she is a professing, Spirit-filled Christian. The ease with which a Christian was able to be taken from their home, committed to a mental institution and summarily injected with psychotropic drugs is shocking. Never mind the




"You can see this light in their eyes," he said before breaking into tears again. Grammer, 67, is a Christian. He's well known for the

## Huckabee Sanders blisters Biden and his 'woke mob' in epic SOTU rebuttal

Arkansas Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders was given the opportunity to deliver the Republican rebuttal to President Joe Biden's second State of the Union address and the rising conservative political star didn't disappoint, lowering the boom on the deeply unpopular leader and his leftist mob.

Following Biden's dishonest, nasty address during which the demagogue in chief defended his handling of the economy and outright lied that Republicans were going to do away with Social Security and Medicare, the former Trump press secretary thoroughly dismantled the octogenarian career politician in an epic response that lasted over fourteen minutes.

"Being a mom to three young children taught me not to believe every story I hear. So forgive me for not believing much of anything I heard tonight from President Biden. From out-of-control inflation and violent crime to the dangerous border crisis and threat from China, Biden and the Democrats have failed you," Sanders began. "They know it, and you know it and it's time for a change."

"Tonight, let us reaffirm our commitment to a timeless American idea: that government exists not to rule the people, but to serve the people. Democrats want to rule us with more government control, but that is not who we are," the newly elected Razorback State governor added. "America is the greatest country that the world has ever known..."

After stressing the importance of her Christian faith in her recent battle with thyroid cancer and her mother's fight with spinal cancer, the governor drew a distinction between herself and the geriatric president, emphasizing that they

have little in common because she is for freedom over heavy-handed government as well as the obvious difference that she is more than four decades younger.

"At 40, I'm the youngest governor in the country. At 80, he's the oldest president in American history. I'm the first woman to lead my state. He's the first man to surrender his presidency to a woke mob that can't even tell you what a woman is," Sanders said.

"In the radical left's America, Washington taxes you and lights your hard-earned money on fire, but you get crushed with high gas prices, empty grocery shelves, and our children are taught to hate one another on account of their race, but not to love one another or our great country," she said.

"Whether Joe Biden believes this madness, or is simply too weak to resist it, his administration has been completely hijacked from the radical left," the governor added. "The dividing line in America is no longer between right and left, the choice is between normal or crazy," she added, as she called for a "new generation" of GOP leadership.

Sanders then set the record straight on Biden's real record instead of his dishonest SOTU malarkey and how the media will spin it, a record that has been nothing short of catastrophic for real Americans.

"And while you reap the consequences of their failures, the Biden administration seems more interested in woke fantasies than the hard reality Americans face every day," she said. "Most Americans simply want to live their lives in freedom and peace, but we are under attack in a left-wing culture war we didn't start and never wanted to fight."

She also spoke of the left's relentless cultural assault on America, a blitzkrieg attack that has captured the nation's institutions and corporations while crushing free speech and punishing those who do not bend the knee to "woke" dogma.

"Every day, we are told that we must partake in their rituals, salute their flags, and worship their false idols...all while big government colludes with Big Tech to strip away the most American thing there is — your freedom of speech," she said. "That's not normal. It's crazy, and it's wrong."

Sanders also reminded Americans of the progress that has been made, especially in terms of race and opportunity, an inspiring message that is the direct opposite of Biden's cynical, dark race-baiting while bolstering the spirits of Republicans for the coming battle that will be necessary to roll back the radical left's period of cultural dominance.

"Make no mistake: Republicans will not surrender this fight. We will lead with courage and do what's right, not what's politically correct or convenient," Sanders said.

"Republicans believe in an America where strong families thrive in safe communities. Where jobs are abundant, and paychecks are rising. Where the freedom our veterans shed their blood to defend is the birthright of every man, woman, and child," she added.

"America is great because we are free. But today, our freedom is under attack, and the America we love is in danger. President Biden and the Democrats have failed you. It's time for a change," Sanders said. "A New Generation of Republican leaders is stepping up... not to be caretakers of the status quo, but to be change-makers for the American people."



## Raised on Lawrence Welk, he turned to heavy metal

His dad was The Lawrence Welk Shows classical jazz pianist, his mom a concert pianist, but David Smale (rhymes with mail) wanted to play heavy metal.

“Wouldn’t you just love for your daughter to date the singer of ‘Cranial Abortion’?” Dave jokes on the Virginia Beach

Potter’s House podcast. They played backyard parties, prompting cops to come and shut it down, until they debuted at a club along with Incubus. With rock ‘n’ roll, came drugs and sex. He progressed from cigarettes at 13, to weed at 14 and LSD at 15.

In the Los Angeles Unified School system, Dave attended middle and high school with Latinos and African Americans who were bused into the San Fernando Valley as part of integration policies.

“We got bullied a lot. We were just these little heavy metal-loving white kids,” he says. “One time this guy said he was going to do a drive-by shooting on us the next day. Because of that, I noticed in my house it was ok for me to express racist things. My dad and my brother would say the N-word and other racial slurs.”

Later he joined a punk rock band “Uneducated,” until his party girl got pregnant and he took up delivering fast food and telemarketing as a high school dropout to put food on the table for his baby and the girl whom he married at 18.

“I remember times stumbling around drunk and high, and all of a sudden, the baby starts crying,” he said, and thought: “I don’t know if I can change his diaper right now. I might put it on his head. It was just awful,” he says. “I was partying and my baby was right there. It was not good.”

Five weeks after his first baby was born by C-section, his wife got pregnant, and the nurse urged her to abort: “You’re going to die,” she said. Leaving the women’s health care center, Dave and his wife felt an eerie sensation. “Did you feel like we just murdered somebody?” she asked. “Yeah, I do,” he responded.

Unable to make ends meet, he eventually decided to join the Navy with hopes of learning a trade. “That was my only way forward,” he says. “I was going nowhere. I was lost in dead-end stuff.”

At 20, Dave looked for a new beginning in the Navy, but the same old addictions and racism didn’t let him get that new start. “I

could wear a uniform, I could stand up taller, I could march in a straight line,” he says. “But I was still fighting addiction.”

Stationed at Point Mugu, California, Dave and his wife got invited to a Baptist church. She was gung-ho, he was blasé. Dave went anyhow, and the sermon

made sense. So, he accepted Jesus into his heart on April 1, 1999 and was born again.

“When I raised my head, everything was different,” he says. “My entire perspective changed in a moment. There was no going back. The cursing went away immediately, the addictions were all gone, the racism was gone. I didn’t hate all the guys in the Navy from different races and ethnicities. I loved these guys who didn’t look like me, but I saw them as God saw me. It blew my mind.”

His wife was pregnant with twins when he got deployed for six months. He kept pursuing Jesus the whole time, but when he came home, he realized his wife had given up on God and church. “The laundry was piled to the ceiling. Checks had bounced,” he says. “There was no food in the house.”

He coaxed her to return to church with him, but she persisted in the party life. For months, he tried to win her over, but she left him when he got orders to Virginia Beach.

Stung by the abandonment, Dave decided to backslide. He went straight to the oceanfront and ogled every girl in a bikini. “At that point, I was so mad, so bitter, so upset, I completely decided to backslide,” he acknowledges. “I was on the warpath to find me a girl and do something that I would have totally regretted.”

But every time he leered with lust, the Holy Spirit smote him with conviction. “Deep down I knew every time I looked at a woman, I felt cut to the heart. Oh man, I shouldn’t be looking.”

After an hour, he abandoned the beach and decided to go to church. Returning to his car, he was con-





## James O’Keefe confirms departure from Project Veritas

James O’Keefe, the undercover journalist and founder of Project Veritas, posted a video to the website Vimeo on Monday, announcing he would be leaving PV amid a dispute with the nonprofit’s board of directors.

One America News (OAN) reporter and Veritas-linked journalist Neil McCabe tweeted out the announcement late Monday morning.

Exclusive: @JamesOKeefeIII, my friend and former boss at @Project\_Veritas just read his resignation letter to his former team and board members at their Mamaroneck, N.Y. headquarters,” McCabe wrote. “James will make his own way—as he always has before.”

Known for his various sting operations and undercover stories investigating lawmakers, government agencies, private corporations and celebrities, O’Keefe sought to hold true to the organization’s motto: “Be Brave And Do Something.”

The group’s leader was placed on paid leave earlier this month seemingly related to a dispute over the removal of two board members. In O’Keefe’s

quest to remove them, the board reversed his decision and issued a memo with more general complaints about the working conditions and management attitude at PV.

Despite the board attempting to tamp down rumors of O’Keefe’s imminent departure, he posted a video to the website Vimeo, detailing how he was stripped of his authority.

“Journalism is reporting things powerful people want kept hidden for the wrong reasons,” he said during the 45-minute video. “Moral wrongs. Bad behaviors. As journalists we’re the custodians of the public’s conscience. And as we’ve gone deeper and deeper, exposing and illuminated corruption ... the line separating good and evil becomes more clear — not just in the institutions we investigate, but within one another. Throughout my 13 years doing this, our mission has evolved from simply being about exposing the truth with some hidden cameras to something more transcendental: giving people hope. That’s what we do.

“... I have felt a lot of despair and seen a lot of evil and felt overcome with various emotions over the last few weeks. You could say I’ve seen glimpses

of heaven and hell — of darkness and light. What I take away from these is the gratitude I have ... What makes us great is we do this work because



we actually believe in this ... we don’t sell out.”

O’Keefe began to become emotional on camera and said he had his power taken from him and was, in effect, forced out. He then followed up with a story about his father and why he does what he does.

“I do love many of you,” O’Keefe said. “I never said it, those words, but I’ll say it now. I still believe we have a long and bright future together somehow, some way ... When I left the office on Feb. 6 after being stripped of all my authority, I saw my father and gave him a hug. Realizing just how honest and real the man he is. Both my

parents are as genuine and down-to-earth as a son can ever have.”

He then spoke about his experiences being raided by the FBI and how he felt persecuted by the government.

“There were federal agents showing up at my parent’s house,” he related. “There were no donors, no supporters, and I was not trending on Twitter. My father went through this hell with me and stood up to those bullies on the front lawn and told them to stop harassing my family. And at that point that’s all I had, was him. I was otherwise completely alone. I will never forget that. Now the good news, we’re no longer alone. We have millions of Americans who also know who I am.

“The mission will perhaps take on a new name, and it may be no longer called Veritas or Project Veritas. I’ll need a bunch of people around me, and I’ll make sure you know how to find me.”

O’Keefe did not immediately respond to a request for comment.

“He just resigns and walks out the door to start a new life,” said McCabe. “Now we’ll see: does the organization he created survive?”

found their identity in Christ, but they had no concept of Christian praxis, or how to apply the teachings of the Bible into daily life.

For most, this praxis became a routine of Bible studies, worship gatherings, conferences, and outreach. And that was admirable. But then something happened. We all left college. A few of my friends managed to snag jobs in campus ministry themselves. I tried this same route for a short time as well. What was a Christian on fire for the Gospel supposed to do in the big bad world? Weren’t we supposed to eschew all material possessions and live like David-Platt radicals on the road??

In my own life, I soon faced the reality that life is not like college. There were bills to be paid. I had a marriage to maintain. Kids were soon on the way. For a time, I felt less than, as if I had given into worldly things.

In the meantime, I saw many of my college friends began to slip away from the faith. The world was choking them out. They moved in with girlfriends and boyfriends, stopped going to church, went full woke, and began pursuing whatever thing gave them that emotional high they once chased in campus ministry. I even know of one who was arrested for an utterly heinous crime the likes of which you’d never think possible for a guy who sat down and read Scripture with you.

I heard this trend put best by a woman who once tweeted about how she lost her faith. She grew up feeling like she was deeply in love with Jesus, but then she attended a Taylor Swift concert with the same emotional vibe and she realized she just liked the high she got from attending concerts.

People like this were once sold out for Jesus, but they had never been prepared to apply their faith in real life—the realities of working for food and housing, of love, commitment, and parenthood, or the slow, sometimes seemingly boring task of following Christ.

Consider the sower who went out to sow. As he sowed, some seed fell along the path, and the birds came and devoured them. Other seed fell on rocky ground where it didn’t have much soil, and it grew up quickly since the soil wasn’t deep. But when the sun came up, it was scorched, and since it had no root, it withered away. Other seed fell among thorns, and the thorns came up and choked it. Matthew 13:1–23

The Christian faith is about endurance. Our

faith is not one of perpetual emotional roller-coasters like some romance thriller. Consider the seed in the Parable of the Sower. Healthy and deep roots are the most important part of the plant. They hold the plant steady and create the very basis for nourishment that will allow growth. Without them, the plant quickly dies.

But if the plant is placed among thorns AND has no soil to grow roots (like Christian college kids with no foundation who are turned out into the secular workforce)—the situation is doubly desperate.

Consider how the foundation of a house is built. Builders can spend months getting it right — all you may see for weeks is a hole in the ground, and then when the walls start going up, it goes up rather quickly. Many people, whether in faith or in other areas of life, are in too fast a rush to stop doing that boring, dirty earthwork that isn’t seen or appreciated and doesn’t yet bear fruit.

Let me give you another illustration from the family. Anyone married longer than five minutes will tell you that constant drama (especially for the sake of drama) in a marriage will ultimately destroy it. In the same way, if you constantly yank your kids from one adventure to another, the lack of stability will hurt them. Children do best with routine (sometimes to the annoying point of requesting an exact sequence of events at bedtime that you have to get right OR ELSE).

Yet we treat our obedience to, discipline from, and discipleship in the Creator of the universe as if it is this simple lovestruck high filled with divine energy. Do you not see that we often look more like our Heavenly Father when we faithfully do our work, tithe, parent, repair our homes, and pay our bills?

But taking your kid to the doctor for the glory of God doesn’t sound NEARLY as appealing as multi-day worship experiences, even though these mundane acts of obedience are where most of our discipline and faithfulness to God are displayed.

“We encourage you, brothers and sisters, to do this even more, to seek to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you, so that you may behave properly in the presence of outsiders and not be dependent on anyone.” - 1 Thessalonians 4:10-12

That’s what concerns me about Asbury.

Back to Samuel Sey’s coverage of what’s happening:

I’ve talked to current students, recent graduates, and several people who’ve visited the chapel to experience the “revival”, and there’s unquestionably several reasons why we should be concerned.

Though one student says the gospel has been consistently and explicitly preached since the beginning of the “revival”, others contradict that claim. In fact, one former student who was at the chapel this week told me he rarely, if ever, heard a clear presentation of the gospel at the school.

Another student said: “Attending the few chapels I have at seminary, apart from one [or] two chapels that preach a biblical message of repentance, it’s always been about ‘being who you are’ and God loving you ‘as you are.’ There are a lot of messages that are about being ‘true to yourself.’”

I’ve watched hundreds of videos of the “revival”, and I still haven’t seen any clips showing a clear preaching of the gospel. Of course, that isn’t evidence that people aren’t preaching the gospel.

This type of emotional fluff won’t lead to “revival”: It’s a mix of genuine worship and emotional existentialism that has no ability to call our culture to repentance outside the groupies that want in on the experience.

• Will this emotional worship set lead some people to Christ? Yes. Praise the Lord!

• It is causing international conversation that is making the name of Christ known? Yes. Praise the Lord!

• Is it setting hearts on fire for reaching a broken world with the good news of eternal life? Yes. Praise the Lord!

“What does it matter? Only that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is proclaimed, and in this I rejoice. Yes, and I will continue to rejoice because I know this will lead to my salvation through your prayers and help from the Spirit of Jesus Christ.” Philippians 1:18-19

But is it going to radically change our culture, lead us away from our societal decline, and lead

to repentance across the land? No. It won’t. I know because I have seen it before.

What our country needs is not just a “back to Jesus moment.” It needs the hard truth that it is quite literally damned to hell on its current path and that there is a lot of difficult, monotonous work that will be required to set it right — if something is even possible at this point of societal collapse.

College worship experiences will not lead to this type of repentance in heart and action. We can see this from Scripture. When the Israelites had so wholeheartedly sold themselves out to idols and demons, it took the total destruction of their nation and 70 years in slavery to rend their hearts enough to make them turn back to God.

One more thought from Samuel Sey:

In desperation for any semblance of hope for our culture — some Christians have abandoned all discernment and they’re eager to idolize anything or any “revival” that profess Christ.

But our hope isn’t in a change in our culture. Our hope isn’t in a revival. Our hope isn’t in a Christian culture. All of these are good. We should earnestly pray that God would change our culture.

But our hope isn’t in the return of a Christian culture. Our hope is in the return of Christ.

So don’t spend too much time obsessing over Asbury. Asbury is not where the battle for culture is being fought. The participants are just wide-eyed kids who think they’re lining up for the real battle with no idea what’s ahead.

They’ll soon realize what war, and real revival, is actually like.
