Bas-relief (Low-relief) Sculpting

Bas-relief definition - relief sculpture in which the figure projects slightly from the background.

Working from a model in a fixed extended pose this class will start out with a board coated with a 1/4 inch layer of clay. You will then be instructed on the process of creating a low relief image of the model. This process is a great exercise for painters, people who like to draw and a essential skill for the sculptor. Discussion of the historical significance of bas-relief sculpture will take place and examples shown.
