## Tipsy Tuesdays Watch Party

Tuesday nights in April, join us on Zoom at 8pm for our own informal live watch party of Topsy Tuesday with Gudrun Erla of GE Designs. This April, Gudrun explains how to make her pattern "Strip Joints" which is on sale this month on her website. You can purchase the pattern here. <https://gequiltedesigns.com/collections/pdf-downloadable-patterns/products/strip-joints-pattern-pdf> It uses 2.5" light and dark strips to make an alternating pattern. If you want to sew-along for donation to Christian City, you can make the lap-size version of the pattern with 24 light and 24 dark strips, or make one in any size for yourself. You do not need to purchase the special rulers to make this pattern and Gudrun explains how to cut using standard rulers as well as her proprietary Stripology rulers. Zoom link goes out on Mondays in April to members via e-mail. Even members who aren't making the pattern are welcome to come hang out and chat.

Meeting was called to order at 11:32 AM via Zoom by Kristin Slagle

**Secretary:** Judy: Motion to approve the March minutes as printed in the newsletter was made by Judy Daymont and 2nd by Jane and was passed unanimously.

**Treasurer:** Brandi: It was moved by Jane and seconded by Tina that the Treasurer's budget be increased by \$50 to account for some PayPal fees that were not anticipated. It passed unanimously.

Discussion of PayPal fees for this year. It was moved by Brandi that for the 2022 budget year and forward, committees would account for the cost of PayPal fees, other than those for membership and guests attending meetings. The PayPal fee will be included in the fee for those activities. It was seconded by Jane and approved unanimously. It was moved by Judy B and seconded by Tina to approve the Treasurer's report. It passed unanimously.

**Membership:** Tina: There are now 96 members and 70 monthly mini participants. The Membership Day in March was very successful. Tina will mail out the remaining membership cards and raffle ticket stubs by the end of April.

**Communications:** Wanda: Communications asks that program chairs put the speaker information in the shared spreadsheet so it can be accessed as needed. Wanda is also working to create an opportunity for guild EQ users to create graphic banners for the public Facebook page.

**Facilities:** Kristin: Holy Trinity is waiting for word from the Archdiocese for guidelines for opening the facilities for meetings. We will continue to work with facilities to see when and if they can accommodate us safely.

**Monthly Mini:** Tina: There are 6 openings for Monthly mini donations. She will ask for donations in the April newsletter.

**Challenge:** Evie: Details on how the challenge quilts will be shown will be in the newsletter. Candy will do education on how to photograph quilts for show and tell and for the challenge.

### Do You EQ??


EQ as in Electric Quilt...



It can be any size from a 12 inch by 12 inch to larger wall hanging, to something that might become a Quilt of Valor or a charity quilt. The picture of your quilt must be accompanied by your short story of where you were, how you felt or who you honor. (A few sentences to one paragraph).

This is not a challenge; there will be no voting. We know there is a great deal of diversity of experience of that day among our members and certainly among the innocent people who perished, their families and the heroes who tried to help them.

Our purpose in this project is to show some of that diversity while honoring those we lost.


**Jan & Kristin from Fiber On A Whim**


