We are making “Plus Sign” blocks. Use your own fabric or request block kits by contacting:

**The first date to pick up a block kit is July 1<sup>st</sup> at the PTC library parking lot from 11:30am to 12:30pm.**

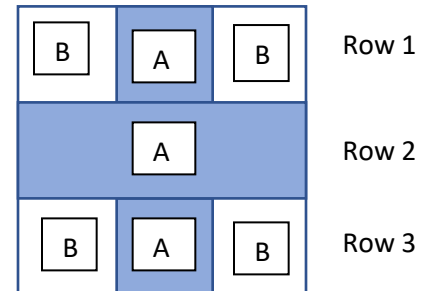
Instructions for “Plus Sign” block:

This block is essentially a nine-patch block with a twist. The block will end up looking like a plus sign (+) and will be 6 1/2” unfinished.



**Fabric requirements:**

- Color A) your fabric - blue, green, yellow, or red – use the same fabric per block  
(The Guild block kit uses assorted colors)  
Cut 1 strip 2 1/2” WOF, sub-cut into 1 rectangle, 6 1/2” x 2 1/2”,  
and 2 squares, 2 1/2” x 2 1/2”
- Color B) your fabric- white- solid or tone on tone  
(The Guild block kit uses white or black)  
Cut 4 squares, 2 1/2” x 2 1/2”



**Sewing instructions:**

Row 1 - Sew three squares together-colors B-A-B, press seams toward the center

Row 2 - 6 1/2” strip, color A

Row 3 - same as Row 1

Sew rows together, press seams toward center.

Block should measure 6 1/2”.

Each quilt will need 85 blocks, so make as many blocks as you can.

We would LOVE to use up the Guild’s fabrics, so I encourage you to order block kits.

**Also, I am looking for volunteers to turn “Plus Sign” blocks into quilts, after blocks have been turned in. This will be in mid-August. You can make a whole quilt yourself, or be part of a team to assemble, quilt, and put on binding.**
