

A small group of stitchers are gathering before the day meeting to learn about stitching on wool. Here are the details:


What: Toned Down, a pattern by Sue Spargo, is a sampler that will explore the many stitches in **Creative Stitching** by Sue Spargo. Karen Shelnutt and Laura Bosma will be teaching the many different stitches.
