

# President's Message - Judy Daymont

Do you remember the 1971 Coca-Cola advertisement featuring the song "I'd Like to Teach the World to Sing"? That version was later rewritten, omitting the cola reference, and it achieved commercial success. I've often thought how I would like to rewrite it, as sort of an anthem for our Community Service initiative. This is my first attempt:

"I'd like to make the world a quilt And wrap it up with love; With triangles and rectangles And appliqued with doves.

I'd like to teach the world to sew With colors bold and bright; I'd like to hold them in my arms 'Til they can see the light.

Go ahead and sing it; it works! Perhaps you can write a stanza or two. Google the lyrics; they are lovely.

I just returned from a mission trip to Romania, where my group of ten packed boxes of food for Ukrainians displaced by the war. Romania has the 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest GDP in the EU and poverty remains high; but they are trying to help those in crisis across the border.

I'd like to think that our quilts provide some comfort to the recipients. Perhaps it is a veteran who sees he has not been forgotten; a young mother-to-be who receives her first baby gift; or a foster child that could pick out her very own bed cover. continue to be awed at the number and beauty of the quilts that you all make to give away to people you don't even know. And I appreciate all that Jennifer Clay and her crew do to facilitate the making of these quilts.




#### **COMMUNITY SERVICE**
