Application Submissions

- 1. All applications must be submitted using the on-line application form
- 2. In case you are unable to save your application before it is completely filled out, we strongly recommend you compile the following information before completing the on-line form:
 - 1. Name and phone number of High School Counselor
 - 2. List of extracurricular activities, the year(s) you served, and any offices and honors received
 - 3. List of community service activities, the year(s) you served, and any offices and honors received
 - 4. List of colleges applied to (or plan to apply to), your acceptance status, and estimated annual cost for each
- 3. Before submitting your completed application, please use the option to print a copy for your records.

Supporting Documents Required

The following are required to complete your scholarship application. For each item below, either upload the document(s) when completing your application, email to MNCrimsonAndCream@gmail.com or mail to the address below. Where possible, format documents in .pdf format or MS Word document. All documents must be received by the application deadline.

- 1. Two letters of recommendation to support your application at least one letter must be specific to this 2022 scholarship.
 - 1. a) One from a current or past teacher
 - 2. b) One from a representative of the applicant's community
- 2. Provide a 500 (minimum) word essay entitled "My Expectations Beyond High School" and attach the essay to your completed application.
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript and copies of your college/university acceptance letters
- 4. Your resume
- 5. Any additional information that will assist our evaluation of your application (only if applicant desires)

Award Eligibility Requirements

- 1. High School Seniors entering a 2-year or 4-year college, university, or other post- secondary institution
- 2. Permanent resident of Minnesota
- 3. Minimum 2.5 GPA
- 4. If selected as a finalist, applicant must be available for an interview with the selection committee in early May

Please note - Family members of any current Crimson and Cream Foundation Board of Directors and relatives of any member of Kappa Alpha Psi are not eligible for awards.
