Tommy Lawrence Memorial Scholarship Application Requirements

For College students entering their Junior or Senior year in the fall of 2026

Application Deadline: March 31, 2026

Application Submissions

1. All applications must be submitted using the on-line application form
2. In case you are unable to save your application before it is completely filled out, we strongly recommend you compile the following information before completing the on-line form:
 1. List of extracurricular activities, the year(s) you served, and any offices and honors received
 2. List of community service activities, the year(s) you served, and any offices and honors received
3. Before submitting your completed application, please use the option to print a copy for your records.

Additional Application Requirements

The following list of documents are required to complete your scholarship application. Where possible, format documents in .pdf format or MS Word document.

1. Two letters of recommendation
 1. One from a current or past Professor
 2. One from a representative of your community
2. Provide a 1000 (minimum) word essay entitled "My Expectations Beyond College" and attach the essay to your completed application. Your essay must address the following questions:
 1. Your vision for your professional career
 2. Your vision for giving back to the community
3. Attach a copy of the following
 1. Your college transcript
 2. Your resume
 3. Attach any additional information that will assist our evaluation of your application (only if applicant desires).

All documents must be received by the application deadline.

Award Eligibility Requirements

1. Current college students entering junior or senior year
2. Permanent resident of Minnesota
3. Minimum cumulative unweighted grade point average of 2.5 on 4.0 scale
4. Demonstrated leadership skills
5. Active volunteer in community service activities
6. If selected as a finalist, completion of an interview with the selection committee.

Please note - Family members of any current Crimson and Cream Foundation Board of Directors and relatives of any member of Kappa Alpha Psi are not eligible for awards.
