

Downtown Business Investment Grant (2023 "Plus-Up" Funding)

This application is open to existing businesses located within Altavista's Main Street District(bordered by Bedford Ave., 7th Street, Main Street, and Charlotte Ave.). Buildings *must* be located in the designated AOT downtown district.

This program will provide existing businesses with financial assistance, up to \$5,000 per business for the following items:

- Reimbursement for "Storefront activation" (e.g., advertising signage, awning, painting, cleaning);
- Reimbursement for Marketing/E-Commerce (website design/redesign, social media, branding, etc.);
- Reimbursement for Training "designed to educate and empower small business owners."

The goal of this Downtown Business Investment Grant (DBIG) program is to give existing businesses a boost to help contribute to the success of those businesses who are investing in the community and catalyze our local commercial district's revitalization efforts. This grant is made possible by the Commonwealth of Virginia's Department of Housing & Community Development, which delineates what DBIG funds can be used for.

Prior to submitting an application, a *mandatory* meeting with the Main Street Coordinator is required to ensure that all requirements are met prior to beginning the application process. <u>Please note that if you are proposing to improve any signage to your business, you must get a sign permit from the Town of Altavista.</u> The Town's sign ordinance can be accessed at this link:

Required Prior to Awarding of Funds:

- Copies of the following from the Town of Altavista: current business license, an approved zoning permit (*if required*) and sign permit (*if applicable*).
- Approved building permit from Campbell County (if required)
- Proof that all Town taxes for a building where grant funds are requested must be current and paid in full.
- <u>Note:</u> Only businesses that generate tax revenue for the Town of Altavista will be considered eligible. Non-profit organizations shall not be eligible for DBIG funding.
- All requests for reimbursement of any eligible expenses MUST be accompanied by copies of receipts, along with a substantive description of the material and/or service(s) purchased.
- Grant will not be paid if business moves or discontinues, breaks any provision of their lease agreement with the property owner(s), or fails to comply with any and all building, fire, health, or zoning codes or regulations applicable to the business through 12/31/2023.
- The AOT Board of Directors maintains full discretion to approve or deny grant uses, based on current downtown market needs and policies of the Commonwealth's Department of Housing & Community Development which oversees this DBIG.
