Main Objectives of Episode 1:

 - A tool that creates new content (text, images, video, etc.) based on patterns it learned during training
- Al Enhances Teaching & Learning (NOT a replacement)
 - O Al supports your work, but your expertise is essential
- Al Anxieties, Myths, & Misconceptions
 - O Addressed common fears and misunderstandings about AI
- Set Realistic Expectations
 - Al is powerful but far from perfect



How AI Works

Understanding Large Language Models

Large Language Models (LLMs):

Advanced Autocomplete

Predict what comes next by identifying patterns learned from training data

Detailed Prompts Work Best:

More detail & context = more accurate outputs

Richness of prompts directly influences the quality of the AI's response. (More details in the next episode!)

Al Hallucinates:

Al generates Text Not Truth

Sometimes produces incorrect information while sounding confident about it



Set Expectations of AI

You Own the Output

Al is Your Creative Partner:

Use it to brainstorm

AI Cannot Make Judgements:

Your professional judgement is necessary

It just puts words (or pixels for images) together based on mathematical patterns



What Can AI Do for You

Enhance Learning & Save Time

Differentiate Content:

Create multiple versions for different learning needs

Create materials & content specifically tailored to each individual student's interests

Helps with Routine Creative Work:

Quickly generate worksheets, quizzes, lesson ideas, course content, etc.

Al Needs Your Guidance:

- 1. Prompt
- 2. Review
- 3. Adapt the output



AI Anxiety

Cheating:

Students already use AI – teach them how to use it ethically and effectively
