The Lord continued to be at work, we prayed for laborers, and 60 came. He blessed the July Back to School Mission Week. Missionaries from Buck Creek BC, Longs, SC, Ben Avon BC, Spartanburg, SC, Wampee BC, Longs, SC, Indian Lake BC, Northport, AL, and Memorial BC, Frankfort, KY came to serve.

They loved and served more than 400 children and parents. It was like a festival. The children received prayer, hotdogs, snowcones, cotton candy, face painting, haircuts, played games, new clothes, and shoes...the missionaries shared about servanthood while they washed the children's feet. Most important the Holy Spirit saved 13 Souls. Tears of joy and laughter were present. The physical and spiritual needs were met; God honored the prayers and work.

The missionaries served in another county school; they also prayer walked the local churches they attended. Through the resource center, FCM supplied 31 children in lower Harlan County with school clothes and shoes.

We thank each one that came to serve Jesus Christ this summer. Continue to share His love with the folks on your path.

The Lord sent some Minnesota teenagers and leaders to work with the Tri-City ministries. They served well at Freedom Center. We thank the Holy Spirit for fruitful labor, young Larson trusted and believed in Jesus to be his Savior. Please pray for his sister Lynn to believe.

As the Cumberland River banks overflowed behind the warehouse, two trucks/trailers from South and North Carolina arrive with donations. God is on time, the rain stopped the Sun shined while we unloaded donations in the warehouse. Again the rains continued, thanks for the break, Lord.

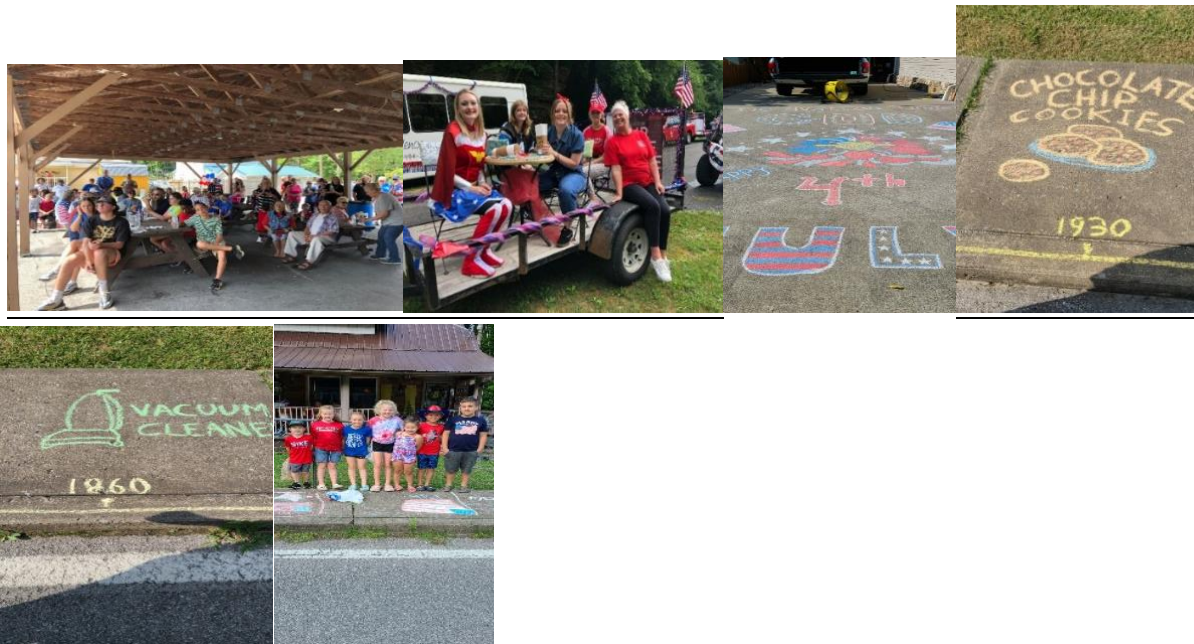
Most of our county, Harlan County was spared from the flood, but several counties north of us were devastated. Loss of life, homes, and cars down the rushing creek. We prayed about how to be God's hands and feet in the Eastern Kentucky relief. After the direction, we contacted our source with a Knott County School and received a needs list. We gathered tools, cleaning supplies, box fans, shovels, blooms, and other needed stuff. As we drove through the flood zone the power of water was witnessed, we saw piles of debris, and the towns and houses were destroyed.

As we arrived at the Beaver Creek Elementary School I walked by a red truck, a lady called out to me, I need a box fan! I responded just a moment I have one. She thanked me as I put it in the back of her truck. God our provider never fails. I did not know how much a box fan would mean to someone.

FCM networked with 11 churches to provide needed items for flood relief cleanup. Many volunteers made several trips to carry groceries, baby food, cleaning supplies, cooking equipment, personal goods, and so much more to flooded areas.

In the next phase, volunteer carpenters have planned to rebuild and prepare homes; this will be a 1 to 2-year process. At this time these materials are needed: drywall, drywall screws, lumber, wood screws, and floor and wall insulation.

We heard the stories of physical pain, hurting, and angry folks throughout the county; they have lost all hope. The volunteers listened and shared their Hope in Jesus.
