The children and teachers enjoyed the excitement as games were played, and with the gifts they received. Each one (14,500) received a Hope Box of toys/home-sewn dresses, personal hygiene, and a Bible. The faces of joy and the children's hugs are very precious. Each servant/missionary says, "I am looking forward to next year, it was amazing".

Pastor Steve and George have continued to visit the prison. We are blessed to follow Jesus on this journey as we go minister to and encourage James, our brother. And tell him to trust God and continue to believe. And know that Jesus still loves us in our sin. With love, God sent His Son, Jesus, into the World so we may live through Him.

The Freedom Center is God's ministry; He has us here as stewards/directors. We continue to see God bring folks in for prayers. Throughout the day, in conversations, relationships are made. The ministry is to be about encouraging, listening, and loving the folks. And helping them

find a pair of shoes or some clothes. We pray with folks, for it is a house of prayer. God is faithful; He is our provision!

The Freedom Center taxi traveled to several counties, taking folks to doctor appointments, drug stores, and shopping. They have moved into our area without a vehicle, so Robin has assisted them with social services (registering for electricity and food stamps). The Lord has put them on our path. Some are now faithfully attending worship at church, praise Him. Also, several women from the church have served with us at the Center.

The widow ministry is to Look After and honor widows and show compassion. We have given assistance in practical needs and given words of encouragement for emotional and spiritual needs.

The “Pick of the Litter of Kentucky” ministry has been working with new volunteers. The community, creeks, and streets are cleaner and beautiful. Hopefully, this will help our water system.

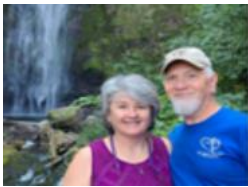
Throughout the world, cultures are different. As we serve in Kentucky, we learn about the mountain culture's likes and dislikes. The folk's needs are items of necessity. The clothes culture is blue jeans, hooded sweatshirts, flannel shirts, t-shirts, and boots/casual shoes. There are very few exceptions. The folks do not wear 100% wool, corduroy, old-style heavy sweaters, pleated pants, turtlenecks, shirts with advertisements, men's suits, or outdated clothes.

So, to be good stewards, the ministry will respect the culture and provide only basic needs. Also, this will help with seasonal warehouse space.

The ministry's needs are basic: shoes, bed sheets, bed blankets, comforters, towels, and houseware that includes pots, pans, and silverware only. Thank you for your partnership in God's work and ministry.
