When the schools started back the folks came to get the children ready for those cooler mornings at the bus stops. Thank you for your thoughts and prayers for us and students and teachers. In July, volunteer teams from South Carolina, Alabama, and Kentucky join forces to help host a Back-to-School event for the children and families of Harlan County. It is described as a sort of carnival, with hotdogs, snow cones, popcorn, games, haircuts, and other fun activities for the families. In addition to this, every child that comes through receives two new outfits, new socks/shoes, and underwear donated from the volunteer churches.

One of the highlights Pastor Caines described was that volunteers washed the feet of each child before putting on a new pair of shoes. As the volunteers wash each foot, they tell the children the story of Jesus washing his disciples' feet.

Before the families leave, they hear the Gospel and are prayed over. Pastor Caines of Wampee BC said, attending this trip is one of the highlights of my year. It's like my Christmas. It's incredible to see my people take a week of their vacation in the middle of the summer, to see them collect money, and to give so freely. It impacts the whole church, not just those who can attend."

The volunteer mission teams "encouraged children and their parents with prayers, shared Jesus' love and met physical needs. They served with ministries and schools throughout the community. So many lives were changed and impacted that week – even the lives of those on the mission teams." Go and share God's love and serve Him.



The family of Jamestown BC Conway, SC collected blessings and the men delivered. These items restocked the men's winter clothes and men's boots. Therefore, the local men are so thankful for God's blessings! Also, the JBC brothers went on a vision tour of the area and one said, he is looking for the next journey.

Also, they worked at FC with the donations; they inspected, sorted, and put away the clothes and shoes. Most importantly, they shared Jesus with Bible stories.

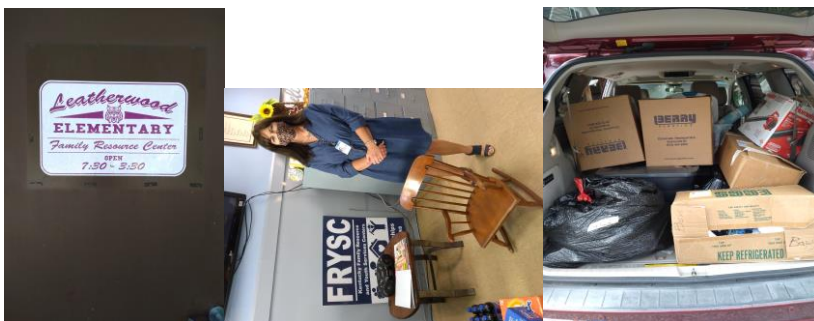
