We worked in Letcher County and Knott County, KY, and gave flood relief provisions. The folks are in the phase of rebuilding and working on their homes. Our contact person said, the most urgent need is an army of volunteers to help. The Topmost community sleeping quarters for female volunteers are the church and the fire department for males. The Agape House in Lynch, KY is a 1 ½ hour drive to Topmost; contact us for more information and to reserve the house.

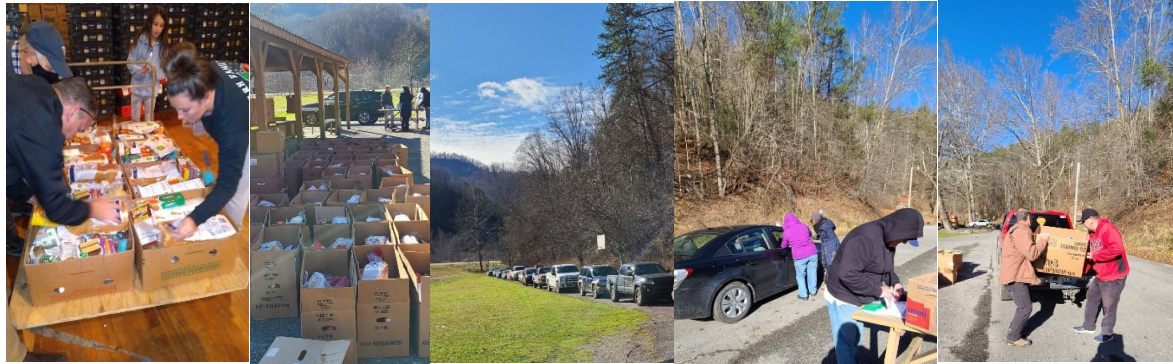

One of the faithful, our 80-year-old friend Howard has made 9 trips with trailers loads of donations, with much-needed food, cleaning supplies, and building supplies. Many kind-hearted volunteers have provided cooked meals and provided physical needs. Through relief teams, many have received Jesus Christ and a new life.

Freedom Center and FBC Salisbury NC missionaries went to Beaver Creek Elementary School in Topmost. We gave the children and staff a hope gift box and shared the Good News. The children requested prayer for their friends and families that struggle through the flood. After we prayed for their request and the community, 16 boys and girls prayed to receive Jesus as Savior! We responded with praise and thanksgiving.

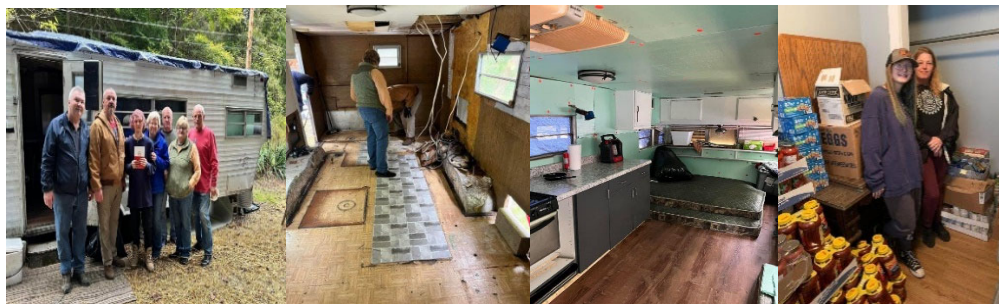
The Jamestown BC of Conway, SC delivered to the Center several donations and helped with the preparations for the coats, toboggans, and gloves giveaway.

FCM SHOP NEEDS AT THIS TIME:

Throughout the world cultures are different. As we serve in Kentucky, we learn about the mountain culture's likes and dislikes. The folk's needs are items of necessity. The clothes culture is blue jeans, hooded sweatshirts, flannel shirts, t-shirts, and boots/casual shoes. There are very few exceptions. The folks do not wear 100% wool, corduroy, old-style heavy sweaters, pleated pants, turtlenecks, shirts with advertisements, men's suits, or outdated clothes. So, to be good stewards the ministry will respect the culture and provide only basic needs. Also, this will help with seasonal warehouse space.

The ministry needs are going to be basic: shoes, bed sheets, bed blankets, comforters, towels, toiletries, and housewares that include pots, pans, and silverware only. Thank you for your assistance in God's work and ministry.
