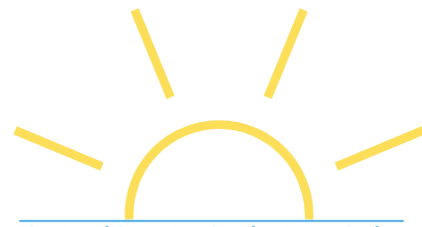

Development School for Youth All Stars Project | New York City
