

Augusta Shores Owners Association Deer Control Rule

Since there is an overpopulation of deer in Augusta Shores, as determined by the Missouri Department of Conservation after they surveyed the property, The Board of Directors (the "Board") has voted to allow limited hunting to help cull the deer in Augusta Shores, both in season and out of season under the terms of a Missouri Department of Conservation permit. There will be a limited number of hunters allowed in seven locations, all out of the way of residences and normal traffic on the roads or boats on the lakes. Signs will be posted in areas where hunting will take place. Safety of all residents, including the hunters will be paramount, and we will obtain extra insurance for this activity.

Motion includes both of the below options:

This motion is put forth to deal with the issue of property damage due to the overpopulation of deer in the development.

1. Allow 7 hunters designated by the Board to hunt in 7 areas designated by the Board during the 2020 Deer Hunting Season following ALL rules of the Missouri Conservation. Individual hunters will be responsible for obtaining their own hunting license/permit and responsible for removing/harvesting their own deer with no waste abandoned on Augusta Shores property; AND
2. Allow 7 designated hunters to hunt in 7 designated areas after Deer Hunting Season ends in January 2021 by special permit from the Missouri Conservation following these rules:
3. All hunters will use bow/arrow except Goble and Lindsey, and they will use a suppressed rifle.
4. Hunting hours will be one hour prior to dusk until one hour after dawn.
5. All deer are eligible (age and gender)
6. Special permit is initially limited to 10 deer, with an option to request more.
7. Special permit is limited to 30 days, but can be extended.
8. No hunting during prescribed deer season.
9. Deer are to be harvested or buried in prepared grave.
10. Will need to bait 2 weeks prior to start of hunt.
11. Missouri Conservation will visit Augusta Shores prior to hunt to confirm continued damage due to deer. Special permit is contingent on their approval.

Terms applicable to both hunting options:

ASOA to obtain insurance for designated hunters covering 1 year in the amount of \$2M. Cost to be paid by ASOA: Not to exceed \$1000:

- \$365 for insurance
- \$50~ for corn to bait
- \$400~ to dig grave site for deer

Warnings / Precautions for residents:

- Signs to be posted during the hunt so residents know to stay away from the designated sites.
- Notification to residents will be included in the fall newsletter.
