Water Usage: By signing this document, you grant Walker's PressureWash the unrestricted right to use the on-site water supply as necessary to finish the specified project. If an external water source is necessary, there will be an extra cost. Prior to our arrival, it is the client's duty to confirm that the water supply is operational. If there is no water, there will be extra fees.

Concerns with Color and Tone: The characteristics and species of the wood, as well as age and weather, can have a significant impact on the stain's final hue or tone. Due to the wood's varied densities and other characteristics, variations may appear on both individual boards and the entire undertaking. The finest representation of the final finish's color and tones is made by Walker's PressureWash and its affiliates. Even though we can frequently offer you a general idea of the color or tone, you must be prepared for some variation in the overall finish.

Use of Electricity: By signing this document, you grant Walker's PressureWash the unrestricted right to use an on-site electricity source as necessary to finish the specified project. If an external source is necessary, there will be a fee.

Payments: Payments to Walker's PressureWash must be made by check or cash according to the contract's due date. Every outstanding balance is due when the work is finished. Any deviation from this rule requires prior written consent and a change to our contract. All balances that are not paid in line with the conditions of the contract will be charged late fees promptly. Customer agrees to cover all collection expenses made by Walker's PressureWash in connection with the effort to collect unpaid balances.

Scheduling: It can be challenging to plan when your company's productivity depends on the temperature. Poor weather could have an impact on plans. Although we make every effort to avoid scheduling conflicts, events outside of our power might have an impact on the start and end dates of your project. You'll be informed if there are any adjustments.

Damages of Property: Walker's PressureWash is not accountable for damages due to improperly installed siding, loose shingles or siding, broken or opened windows, incorrectly sealed windows and doors, wood rot, faulty construction, wrongfully secured wires, loose or improperly installed gutters, and leaders and improper caulking. The sun and weather will always bleach the color or cause fading in instances involving aluminum siding, as well as occasionally with vinyl siding. The faded features of the vinyl or aluminum may stick out when power washing because it removes chalky, grit, or failing surface materials. Such circumstances are not the responsibility of Walker's PressureWash. When cleaning, any loose mortar that comes free won't be the Walker's PressureWash's fault.

Concrete: The period of the concrete's initial pour and curing are the main determinants of how the concrete will look. Any flaws that the pollutants and stains covered up will now be fully exposed after the concrete has been cleansed of the dirt, mold, mildew, algae, and other pollutants and stains. The client is aware that, whether it's the same driveway, patio, walkway, or concrete slab, not all concrete will have the same appearance.

Deck Contents Removal & Replacement: The homeowner is responsible for the removal and replacement of grills, deck furnishings, planters, and any other things. The removal of artillery fungus from external home surfaces cannot be guaranteed by Walker's PressureWash.

Window Spotting: Windows may become water spotted as a result of our services. By signing a contract with Walker's PressureWash, you are signing a legally binding contract for work to be completed at an agreed-upon price. In the event that you break this contract, all deposits made to the company shall be surrendered as damages.
