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Notes:

- There will be a rider meeting every morning.
- All adults on the premises must sign the waiver and pay for entry/wristband (riding and non-riding). A wristband must be purchased for each person traveling in your party to enter.
- Children under 18 must have a waiver signed by both parents. If only one parent is present, the signed waiver must be notarized before arrival.
- All riders should have proper safety equipment on when riding, this is not negotiable for children (boots, helmets & gloves at a minimum).
- The hydration station, sponsored by **Montana Honda, Kawasaki, Suzuki** will be available 24/7 and is complimentary. Sample packets of LMNT will be available all weekend. Complimentary drip coffee will be available at 7 am every morning.
- We're lining up a great selection of truck vendors that will be on-site throughout the weekend. We'd suggest packing your own breakfast foods and anything else you might want on arrival and departure days. Remember that restaurants/grocery stores/other services are only 3 miles away from the campout.
- You will have full cell service at the campout.
- The Dirty Poker Run is 95% dirt & gravel; bikes must be plated as the first 5 miles will be highway into Red Lodge and through downtown. The full distance is about 90 miles.
- All camping will be first come, first serve. We cannot save spots or guarantee that you will be parked next to your friends. We suggest arriving together if you want to camp together. There are no public showers on the property, so plan to bring a camp shower, brush up on your remote travel hygiene skills. Porta potties will be available. Showers are available at Red Lodge City Pool for an \$8-day pass.
- We are in the wild west, so please be mindful of our rare, local neighbors - including but not limited to: moose, bears, mountain lions, coyotes & fox.
- Firearms, fireworks and personal campfires are not permitted.
- Dogs must be leashed and under control at all times.
- Children, dogs and snacks must not be left unattended.
