

Winnebago County Republican Party Caucus Resolutions passed on 2-6-2021
#1 ELECTION REFORM

WHEREAS free and fair elections are the cornerstone of the American republican system, and

WHEREAS the American republican system establishes a government of the people, by the people and for the people, relying on the faith and trust of all citizens in our electoral process, and

WHEREAS the rule of law, not rule by the elected or appointed, must be the only force in the land, and

WHEREAS numerous changes have been adopted in our history to improve the electoral process and to ensure all eligible voters the right to vote including the 19th amendment to the Constitution, the 1965 Voting Rights Act, voter ID requirements and several other reforms, and

WHEREAS in 2020, the clear and plain language of election laws in Wisconsin beginning with the Spring election and continuing through the November election appear to have been changed, or allowed to be altered, by directives of the Commissioners and staff of the Wisconsin Elections Commission, and

WHEREAS the WEC and staff denied the Green Party Candidate for President access to the ballot, refused removal of over 200,000 voter registrations as required by state law and the ERIC system, instructed clerks across our state to allow online requests for absentee ballots using the Indefinitely Confined Elector status without providing identification and instructed clerks to illegally cure absentee ballots with missing information on the mailing envelope in contradiction of state law, and

WHEREAS there were many reports of ballot harvesting in cities across Wisconsin which created an unequal treatment of voters in rural and urban areas which is a violation of the US Constitution's 14th Amendment often referred to as the Equal Protection Clause, and

WHEREAS over 100 signed affidavits testifying to fraud as well as numerous anecdotes of anomalies and irregularities across the State, most notably in Milwaukee and Dane Counties, have prompted lawsuits calling into question the validity of the Wisconsin election by the campaign of President Trump, and

WHEREAS the 2020 Wisconsin election, as regulated and directed by the Wisconsin Elections Commission, has been one of the most haphazard, controversial and poorly managed elections in State history, shaking the faith of citizens across Wisconsin in the very cornerstone of our republic, therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Winnebago County Republican Party calls upon the Wisconsin Legislature to hold hearings and investigate irregularities in the elections of 2020 and to hold accountable the Wisconsin Elections Commission, the agency that has caused such unprecedented turmoil, and be it further

RESOLVED that the Wisconsin Elections Commission should be relocated in a city outside of Dane or Milwaukee County so that initial legal challenges may be heard in courts of law that have not shown the blatant and unabashed partisanship repeatedly demonstrated in these two counties, and be it further

RESOLVED that the Wisconsin legislature should enforce the laws against ballot harvesting and impose severe penalties on those who engage in this practice, and be it further

RESOLVED that this action should be taken as soon as possible so that the faith of the citizens that free and fair elections may once again occur in Wisconsin may begin to be restored.

#2 VOTER PROTECTION AUDIT

WHEREAS Senator Ron Johnson noted that millions of Americans are worried that the 2020 Presidential election was fraught with fraud and called such worries legitimate,² and

WHEREAS Senator Ron Johnson stated, “For the future unity of our nation, it is crucial that states properly shoulder their responsibility, take the action required, and alleviate any doubt that future elections will be fair and legitimate”³ and,

WHEREAS Dominion voting machines have been found to produce errors by as much as 68%⁴, and

WHEREAS cybersecurity experts consider Dominion voting machines to be the worst machines on the market⁵, and

WHEREAS Maricopa County, Arizona, will be conducting a comprehensive audit of all their voting machines to ensure accuracy and voter confidence,⁶ and

WHEREAS counties using Dominion voting machines in Wisconsin have produced results for Biden to be 5% above projections, while counties using other systems find results to be only slightly above or below projections,⁷ and

WHEREAS Winnebago County uses Dominion voting machines, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Winnebago County Republican Party, in caucus assembled, requests the Wisconsin State Legislature to conduct an audit of at least 25% of the Wisconsin voter precincts that used Dominion voting machines in the November 2020 election, by randomly selecting these precincts and hand counting the ballots from the November 2020 election to verify accuracy.

#3 State Education Systems

RESOLVED that the Winnebago County Republican Party, in caucus assembled, recommends the suspension of all state funding to schools who do not allow the exercise of free speech and the presentation of all sides of an issue, and be it further

RESOLVED that State funding should only be provided to schools who accommodate and protect the rights of our children based on their biological gender at birth.

#4 Elimination of W.E.C.

WHEREAS the W.E.C. has usurped power from the State Legislature, and

WHEREAS the W.E.C. has ignored State statute regarding election law, therefore be it

RESOLVED the Winnebago County Republican Party in Caucus assembled urges the Wisconsin State Legislature to circulate a bill to eliminate the W.E.C., and be it further

RESOLVED the Wisconsin State Legislature will assume the duties & functions of the W.E.C.
