- HEART ATTACK
- STROKE
- UNCONTROLLED BLEEDING
- HEAD INJURY with LOSS OF CONSCIOUSNESS
- TRAUMA
- BREATHING ISSUES
- CANCER TREATMENTS
- PREGNANCY

SAMPLES OF NON-ESSENTIAL CARE

- Imaging: X-ray, MRI, CT
- Physical Therapy
- Routine Dr. visits
- Outpatient surgery and diagnostic procedures
