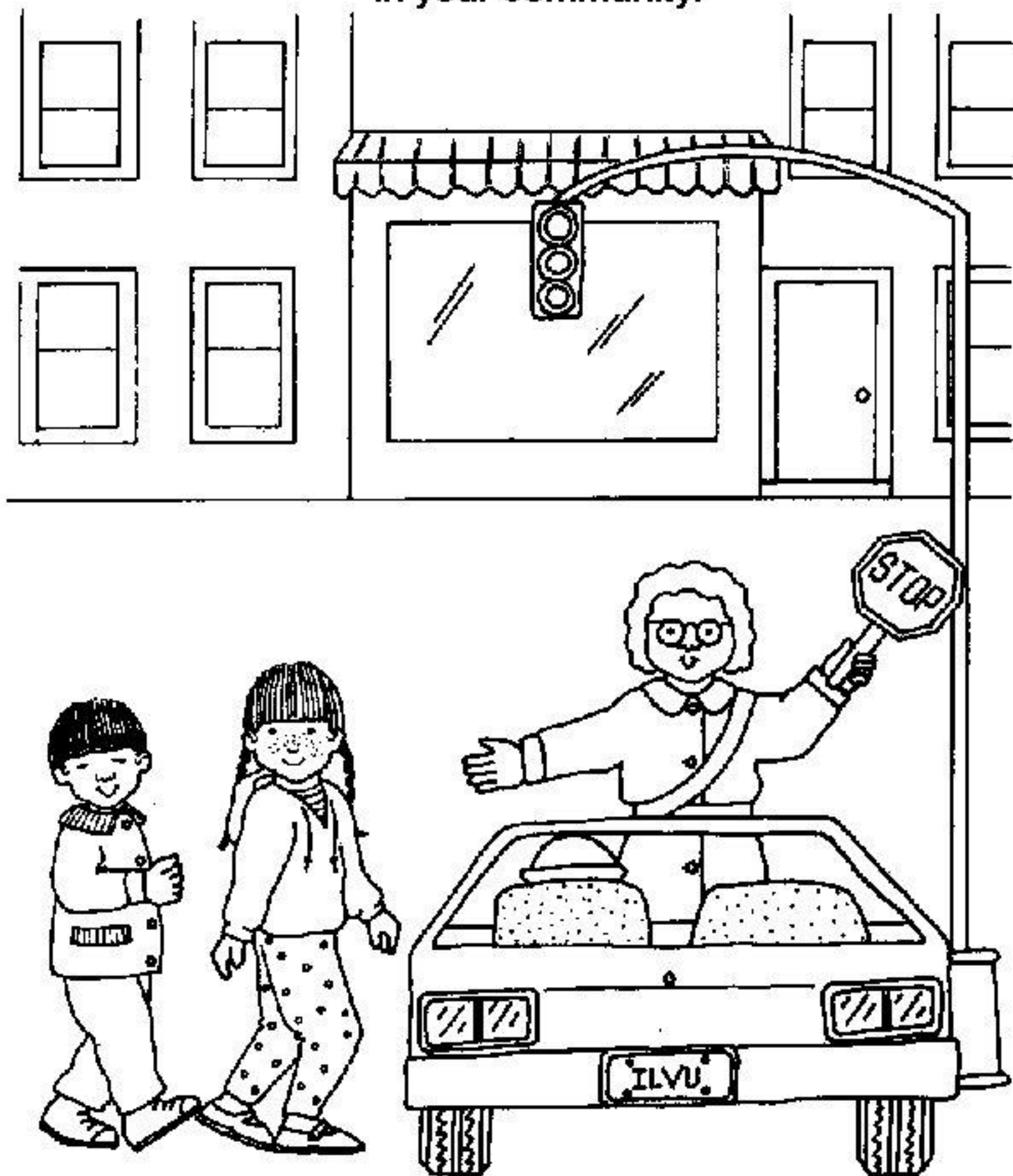


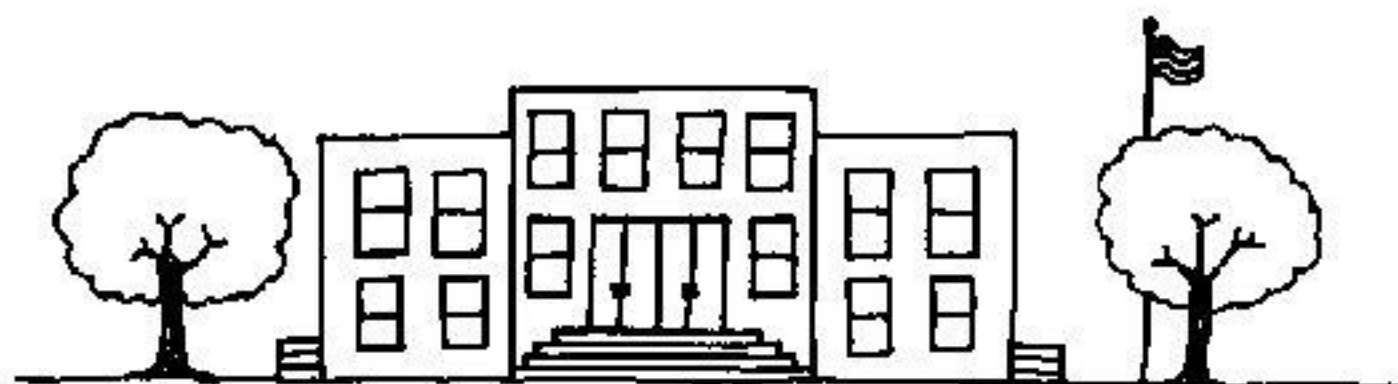


**Do you know the police officers in your neighborhood?

TELL AN ADULT.

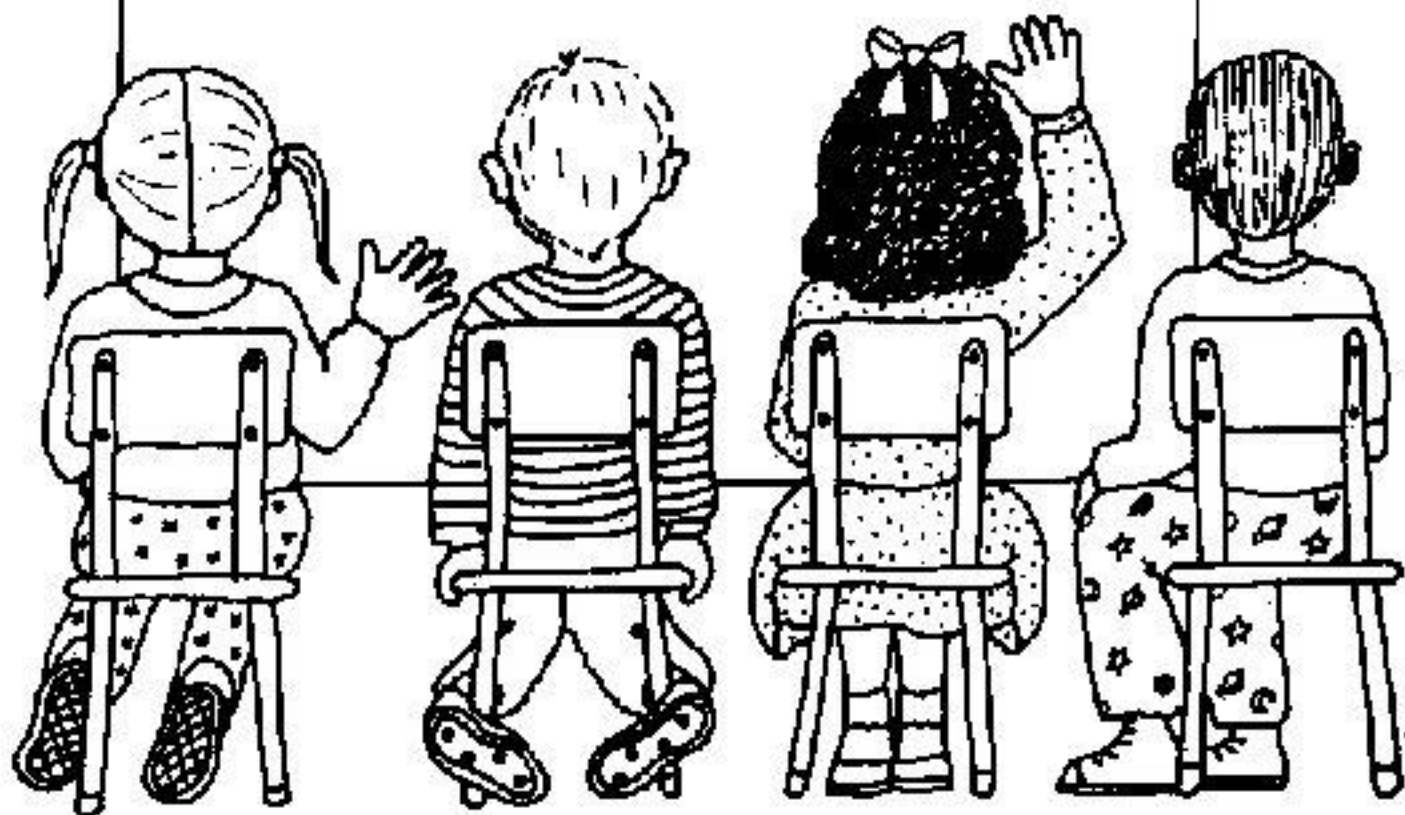
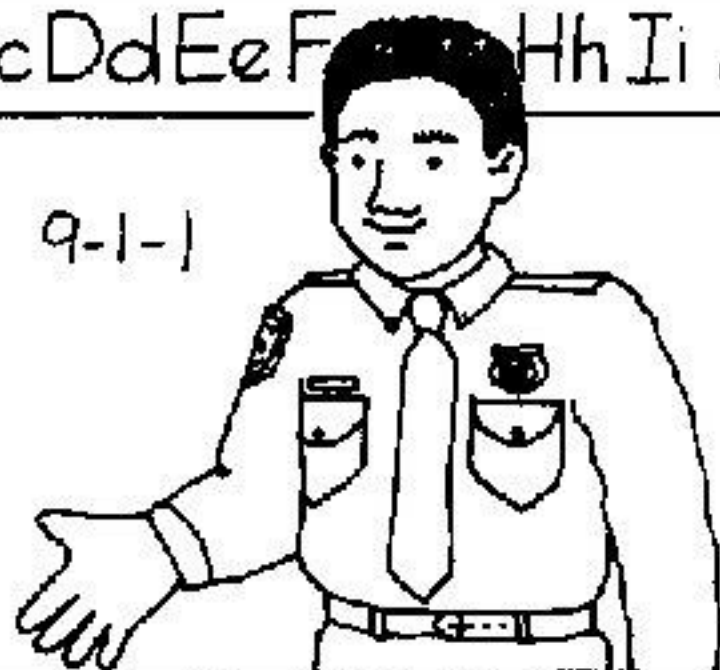


Remember, police officers are your friends. They are there to help you when you need them.

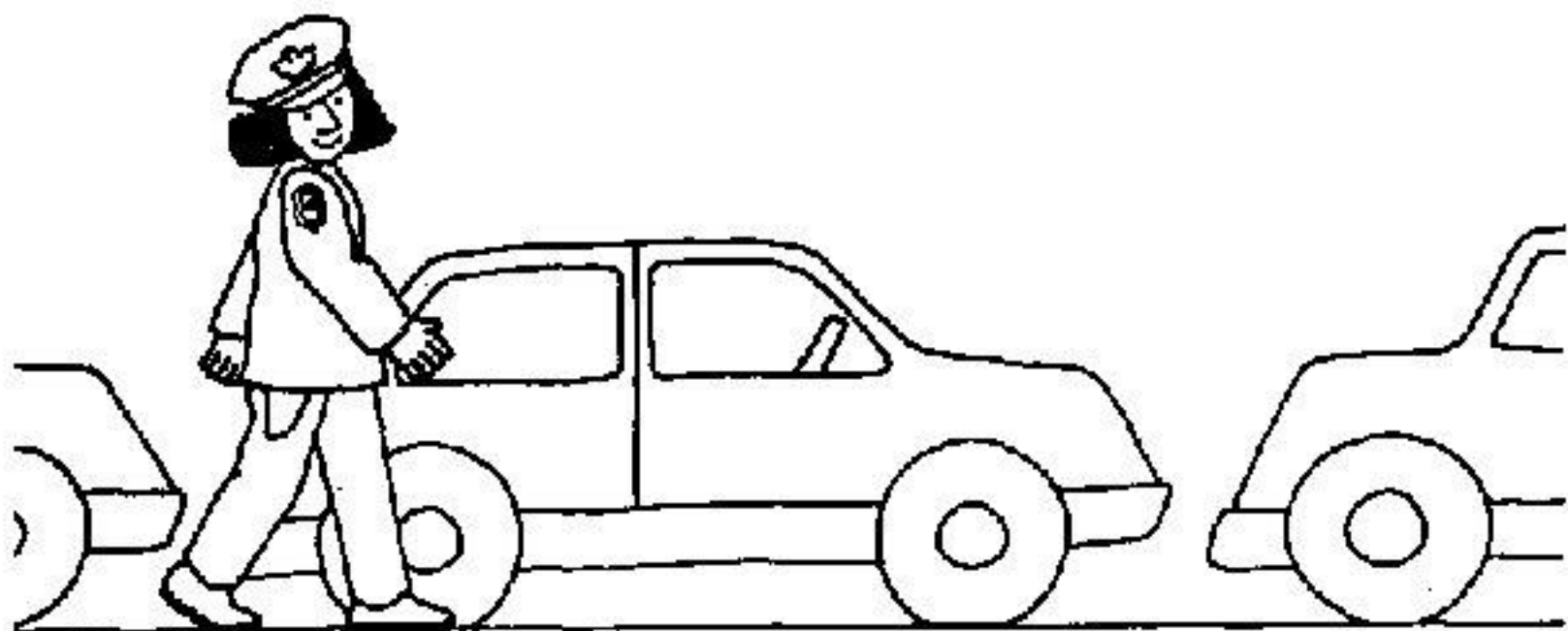

They help if you are lost or hurt.

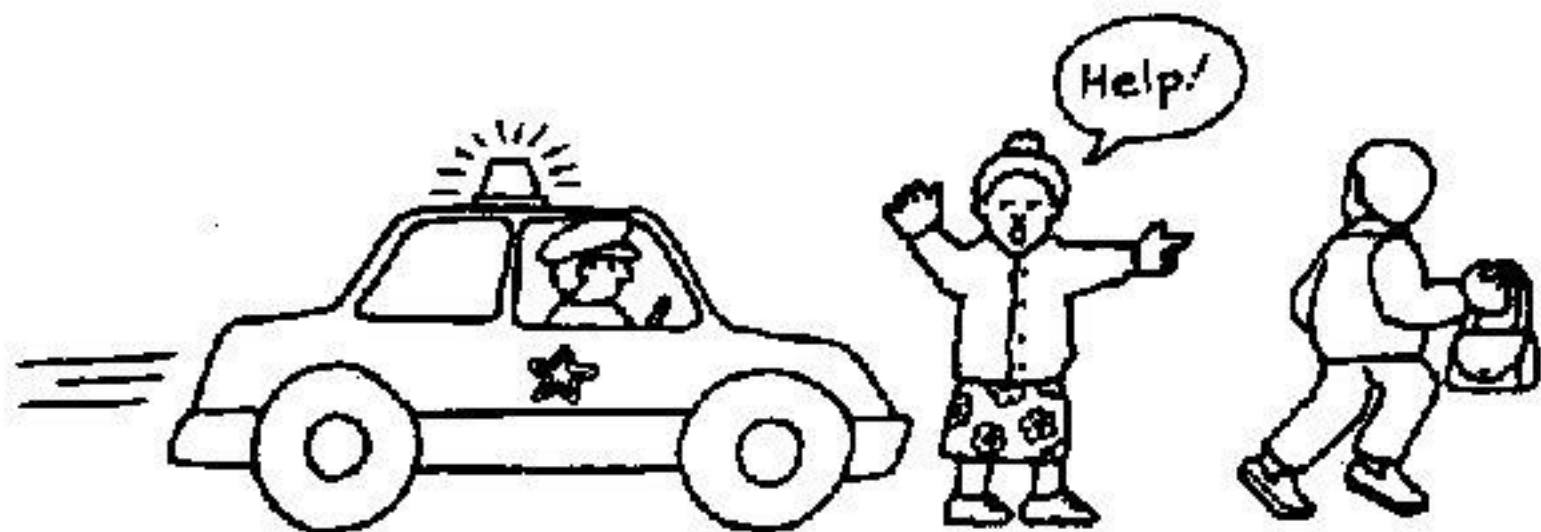


They visit schools to teach kids about safety.

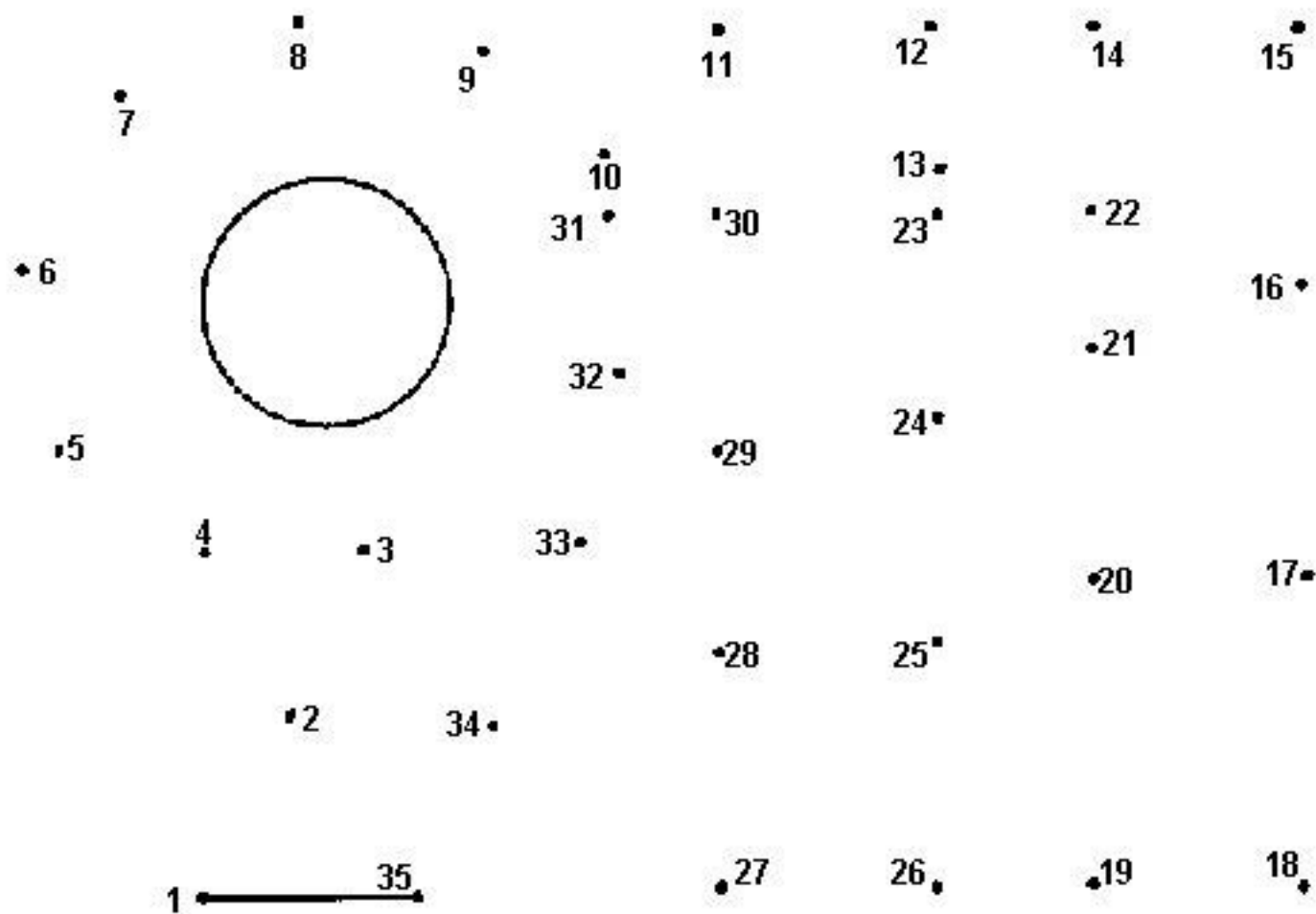


POLICE BATON

Police Officers get training to keep you safe. They must practice using a gun and follow the rules of gun safety.

Dial it if your are hurt, lost or need to report a crime.

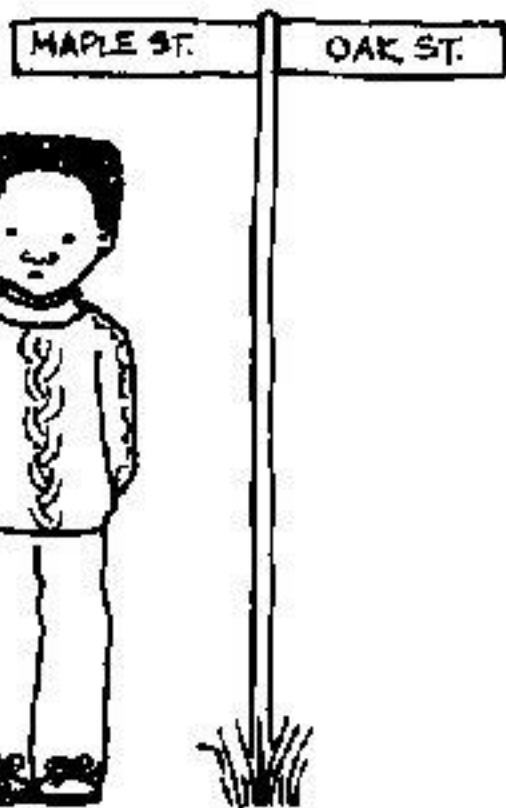
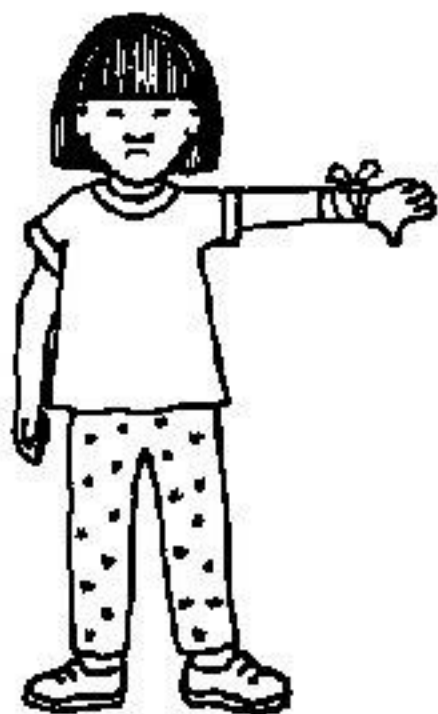


Follow the dots to find out what it is.



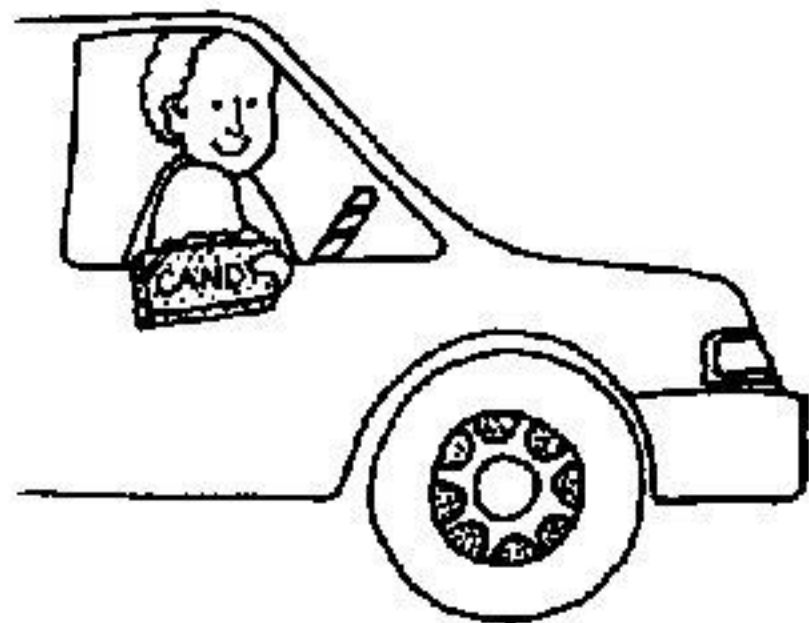
You can also dial "0" for Operator.

Use 9-1-1 to call a Police Officer if:

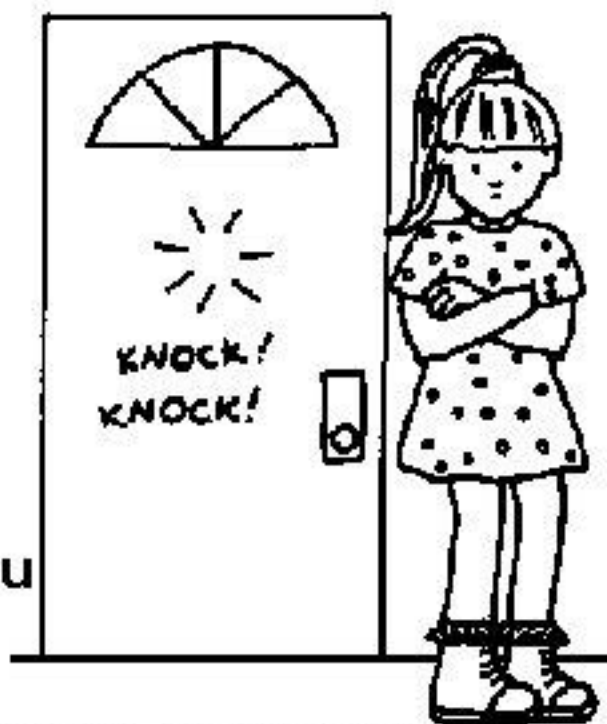


You or someone else is hurt badly.

You are lost.



A strange person tries to offer you gifts or a ride.



You think someone may be trying to hurt you.



To Dial 9-1-1

Pick up the phone. Dial 9, then 1, then 1 again. An adult will answer. This is the 9-1-1 operator.

Remember:
Listen to the operator.
Speak clearly.
Answer any questions.
Don't hang up until the operator tells you to.
