Job Description for Client Advocate

(this position will be part-time 15-20 hrs weekly, staring pay \$15, raises available after training is complete & each 6 months, vacation/sick pay is earned time off 1hr for 30 hrs worked, personal days are available without pay)

Main Duties – 20 hrs of training will be provided before you are on the job with clients

Work with clients according to their needs, providing them information, classes, materials, support and referrals. Clients include women, men, children, teens.

- *Use Pregnancy, Parenting & Life skills educational classes (Bright Course)
- *Use Factual pamphlets, models and other info to teach and advise
- *Access supplies from our storage or garage for clients
- *Perform pregnancy tests
- *Lead support groups
- *Facilitate a healthy discussion in a group or one on one
- *Plan activities for clients & children

*Use a computer for accessing classes, online reporting and making informational sheets

- *Organize equipment (carry baby clothes bins & equipment from the center to storage in garage)
- *Must be able to carry 50 pounds several times per day in order to serve clients
- *Clean the center, vacuum, sweep, bathrooms

- *Attend and assist at fundraising events, including a yearly Gala
