March 10, 2026

The budget hearing was called to order at 6:33PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The council was presented with copies of the proposed budgets for the 2026-2027 fiscal year.

Meeting was concluded at 7:00PM

March 10, 2026

Meeting called to order at 7:00PM, the pledge was skipped due to being recited at the budget hearing.

Roll Call: Trustee Scheuneman, Trustee T. Fish, Trustee Kelly, Trustee Schrems, President Fish, and Clerk Hart were present.

Scheuneman made a motion to accept the agenda, seconded by Kelly. Motion carried.

Scheuneman made a motion to accept the minutes as read, seconded by T. Fish. Motion carried.

Scheuneman made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded by Schrems. Motion carried.

Scheuneman made a motion to accept the Police report, seconded by T. Fish. Motion carried.

DPW/Wastewater

The lagoons were treated over the weekend and they should be discharged in a couple weeks.

President Fish reported that MDOT has requested the village to replace some street signs in the village. Fish is working on completing this.

Old Business

Clerk Hart reported that Frankenmuth Federal Credit Union is offering 7 month CDs at 3.95% and we could earn approximately \$5000 in interest for \$260,000. The council asked Clerk Hart to shop around and bring back rates from other credit unions and banks next month.

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New Business

Scheuneman made a motion to accept the 2026-2027 General Fund Budget, Operation and Maintenance Budget, Local Street Budget, and Major Street Budgets with the following changes being made to the General Fund budget; change President Wages to \$1000 from \$3750, change council wages to \$3750, and change utilities to \$23,000, seconded by T. Fish. Motion carried.

Scheuneman made a motion to transfer \$21738.75 from WWSAS to O&M Checking to pay the interest on the sewer loan, seconded by Kelly. Motion carried.

Clerk Hart informed the council that there would be an ad in the Sunday, March 15, 2026 Citizen's paper concerning a public auction. Bid forms will be provided on the village website along with the item up for auction.

Scheuneman made a motion to pay bills in the amount of \$20546.01, seconded by T. Fish. Motion carried.

Public Comment

It was asked if we can add unanswered public comment questions to old business.

It was asked if potholes on Bockee can be filled.

It was asked when the Memorial flag pole would be replaced. Fish responded in a week or two.

It was asked if Chief Ferguson was going to provide more detailed police reports, Clerk Hart said she brought it up to Chief Ferguson and since it wasn't done for the February meeting, that was the answer.

There were concerns brought up about the purchase of the new plow. Clerk Hart read the invoice details out loud.

It was asked why Ferguson was in Shiawassee County, President Fish said he was assisting an outside agency, more than likely the Michigan State Police.

Scheuneman made a motion to adjourn, seconded by T. Fish. Motion carried.
